

# DO YOU BELONG? YOU DO BELONG.

I know there is someone in your life that you wish would "come to church." We have this underlying hope that someone being at church on Sundays is evidence of them authentically discovering the reality of God in their life and choosing to respond in faith. Inviting someone into that can be difficult. Some deceivingly believe they don't need God or the Church, while others truly believe they simply don't belong. So how do we evangelize?

Evandalism, like putting stickers that say "Jesus loves you" around town, doesn't seem to make a significant difference. Plopping someone in a pew and just expecting them to "get it" is also unlikely to yield faithful results. What's the trick? Accompaniment! It is the art of meeting someone where they are at with love and then walking beside them towards Christ one step at a time.

Our approach is vital! Some people have this approach; that you need to believe and behave, then you belong... There is an expectation that one must make a decision on what they believe and also behave in ways that conform to Christian morals THEN you would be accepted as one who "belongs" in the church. This approach falls short.

Things change when we reorder the approach. When we start with "you belong" we say we want you here because you matter and you are loved. Then the invitation to "believe" changes from an expectation that one must accept everything we say as truth, but now says we want you to come and discover Christ with us. This leads to genuine discovery of the truth because it gives room for one to open their mind and ask questions so that their heart can close on it with confidence. Furthermore, what this changes is not just how someone ultimately behaves but it actually serves as a catalyst to make them become something new, to be transformed by God! Evangelizing starts by telling someone that they belong. Why do they belong? Because of what God has done. If they come to understand that, then everything else will fall into place.

I think my favorite example of this is how St. Teresa of Calcutta loved the poorest of the poor. She did not run around India hitting people over the head with the bible saying "accept Jesus as your Lord and Savior, then I'll give you some food!" She showed up to anyone who was hungry and she fed them. Of course, with food but more importantly, she fed them spiritually too. Even those without hope, the people who were laying in their own filth on the side of the road literally dying from disease, she would at least wash them and clean them up so that, before they died, they were shown dignity having been judged worthy of being loved. I think that kind of witness shows that you belong, you matter, and reveals the purpose with which we live, to glorify God. If the "poverty" in your heart ever leads you to question whether you belong here, look to the cross. You are absolutely, 100%, undoubtedly loved beyond measure! You do indeed belong and I am glad that you are here.
