2nd Sunday of Lent

There is so much wisdom in the first commandment. The daily demands of life, current political ideologies and dynamics, social expectations, corporate philosophies, and even technology can easily become lesser gods. We can find ourselves beholden to and held captive by these secular constructs and systems. Even for those who profess a faith in the one true God, these lesser, attractive but false gods are a temptation. Being overly preoccupied and even obsessed with the state of our present lives, we lose sight of our real destiny and purpose.

Jesus showed his disciples a glimpse of this destiny when he was transfigured before their eyes. In fact, Peter was so caught up in the brilliance, awe, and sacredness of these fleeting moments that he wanted to extend them as long as possible. Wonderful things happen when we leave our illusions and discover something that is true. This is why creating some sacred space in our lives for reflection, prayer, renewal, refreshment, centering ourselves, and disconnecting from the noise is so important. It shows us how false and shallow our lives can be and what is really of importance. Do you create some kind of sacred space in your life? Lent is a perfect time to do so.

St. Irenaeus, one of the early fathers and martyrs of the Catholic Church, said that, "he who was the Son of God became the Son of Man that man ... might become the son of God." We mistakenly believe that life is all about us. It's not. Ours is a journey of transformation in which we become



more and more one with the mind of Christ and Christ himself. St. Augustine saw this same transformation occurring when the Eucharist is received. In receiving the Eucharist, we become what we eat, the Body of Christ. Honestly acknowledging false gods that we cling to can open the door for God to show us the wholeness and holiness to which we are called. Take time to discover the sacred. When we do, we will want to stay there for a while. Then, when we return to our personal affairs, we will see more clearly.

Health Ministry News

March is National Nutrition Month!

Fruits – 1 ½ to 2 cups daily is recommended. See www.myplate.gov for more information on each group
Vegetables -There are 5 groups of vegetables: dark green, red or orange, peas beans and lentils, starchy vegetables and other. Be sure you are getting at least 3 servings daily from a variety of the groups

Grains – Make whole grains part of your daily intake from this group. For women 3-4 oz daily and men 4-5 oz daily.

Protein In general, 1 ounce of meat, poultry or fish, ¼ cup cooked beans, 1 egg, 1 tablespoon of peanut butter, or ½ ounce of nuts or seeds can be considered as 1 ounce-equivalent from the Protein Foods Group. The table below lists specific amounts that count as 1 ounce-equivalent in the Protein Foods Group towards your daily recommended intake.

Dairy 1 cup of milk, yogurt, or soy milk, or 1 ½ ounces of natural cheese can be considered as 1 cup from the Dairy Group. 3 cups is recommended for those over the age of 9.

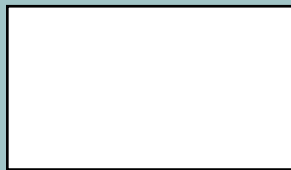

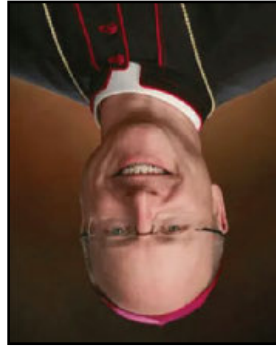

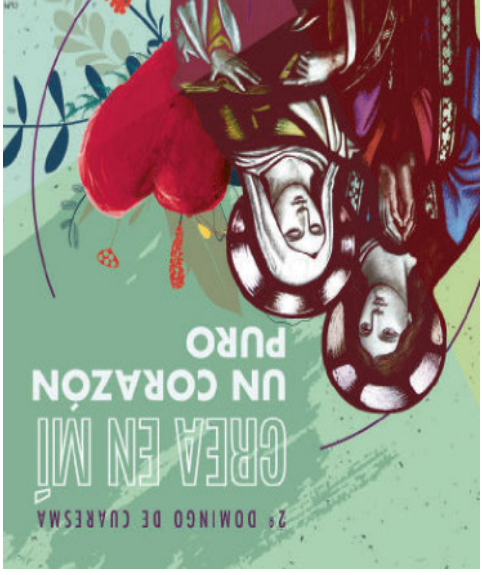


Colecta para Catholic Relief Services

2º Domingo de la Cuaresma

Pedro, sin saber lo que decía, propone a Jesús detener ese momento de gloria para siempre, construyendo tres chozas, una para Jesús y otras dos para sus acompañantes. ¿Qué choza construiremos a Jesús en esta Cuaresma? ¿Cuál es la esperanza que mueve a vivir la vida con esperanza? San Juan, en su Evangelio, indica la cercanía y unidad entre Jesús y su Padre: "Ahora, Padre, dame junto a ti la misma gloria que tenía a tu lado
