

### From the Pastor's Desk



Dear Parishioners,

We are very near the Solemnity of the Nativity of the Lord. The readings for this weekend are very rich with revealing to us the significance of the Christmas event. The first reading from the prophet Micah shares with us that God was very particular where Jesus would be born. It would be in a humble place

in the city where King David himself was born. This shares how Jesus the Messiah is both king and suffering servant. The second reading from Hebrews reveals that Jesus becomes born among us to do the will of His heavenly Father, being completely open and obedient to that will for our salvation. The Gospel shares how the presence of Jesus in the womb of Mary blesses John the Baptist in the womb of her cousin Elizabeth symbolizing the connection between the Old and New Testaments. Mary also shows us her life of charity when she seeks to reach out to Elizabeth.

The staff and I would like to wish you all a very Happy Advent and Merry Christmas! You will be in our hearts and prayers during these weeks of celebration and family. We want to invite you all to our Christmas liturgies and our communal penance service. The penance service will be this Thursday, December 23 at 7 PM at Our Lady of Lourdes Church. A Word Service followed by individual confessions will be done and several priests will be available for the confessions. I want to remind us that we are expected to be at the Solemnity of Christmas AND the Solemnity of The Holy Family. It is a very unique year in this way that the celebrations are the closest they can possibly be. But what a beautiful lesson that the birth and presence of Jesus is what gives sanctity to the life of the Holy Family and to our families!

We want to thank all people who have helped with holiday outreach: musicians, liturgical ministers, holiday baskets, communion calls, Advent and Christmas services, and so much more. Just to note, the parish offices will be closed Christmas Eve. Holy Family will be closed Monday and Tuesday, December 27-28, St. Mary's and Our Lady of Lourdes will be closed on Monday, December 27<sup>th</sup>. These are annual holidays for the staff that normally follow immediately after Christmas Day.
