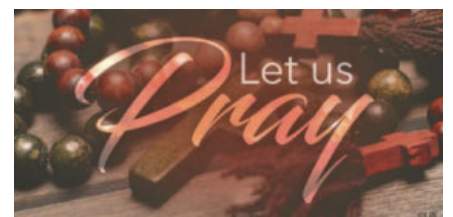

DID YOU KNOW

The Precepts of the Catholic Church

The Church in her wisdom has given us five precepts to follow. These are basically the minimum criteria for active church membership. They are listed in the Catechism of the Catholic Church (2041 – 2043).

1) You shall attend Mass on Sunday and on holy days of obligation and rest from servile labor.

Weekly Sunday Mass is obligatory for all Roman Catholics. There is no such thing as a "dispensation" from the Sunday obligation. Some factors might excuse Sunday Mass attendance (personal illness, or the need to take care of someone suffering from illness, significant travel situations, or certain jobs affecting public safety or welfare). Watching televised Masses or joining in other prayer or Communion services do not satisfy the precept.

2) You shall confess your sins at least once a year

Catholics are required to confess their grave sins to a priest, at least once per year. Strictly speaking, persons free of grave sin are not required to make an annual confession, but all Catholics are strongly encouraged to bring even their venial sins to confession. A "penance service" is a wholesome activity for Christians, but it is not sacramental confession and does not satisfy this requirement.

3) You shall receive the sacrament of the Eucharist at least during the Easter season.

For Catholics in the United States, the period for satisfying this precept has been extended to run from the First Sunday of Lent to Trinity Sunday (after Pentecost).

4) You shall observe the days of fasting and abstinence established by the Church

Most Fridays throughout the year and the season of Lent are penitential times. Since shortly after the Second Vatican Council, the discipline of abstaining from meat on Fridays has been discontinued in favor of the recommendation to perform some other self-imposed penance. Only on Fridays in Lent are Catholics, aged 14 and older, bound to abstain from meat. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, Catholics aged 18 to 59, are also bound to fast; however, they may still take one full meal during that day, and two smaller meals.

5) You shall help to provide for the needs of the Church.

Sunday collections, annual appeals, spontaneous offerings, bequests and wills, are all ways that Catholics are able to satisfy this precept of support.

TESTIMONY

Ava Breitbach's Steubenville Testimony

From July 26th-28th, 50 teens and adults attended the St. Paul Steubenville conference. The theme was 'Illuminate,' highlighting John 1:5, "The light shines in the darkness and the darkness has not overcome it."

Ava Breitbach was one of the youths who attended, it was her first Steubenville experience.

"I have an aunt my age and she has always gone to Steubenville," Ava commented. "This year, she went to Steubenville Ohio [...] That made me want to experience Steubenville."

"[My faith] was rocky; I did not know how to be strong in my faith, how to pray, how to read my Bible. Last year, I got back into my Catholic faith, so I felt behind. Doing everything at Steubenville made me feel like, 'Oh yeah, I know this.' [Steubenville] made me feel closer to God, not behind."

Ava's highlight from Steubenville was the Mass, watching all the priests processing in, and the unity in the Consecration prayers, when the priests extended their hands to pray. "Watching everybody receive Communion was awesome!" she added.

One common highlight of Steubenville conferences is adoration. Although Ava did not have a powerful experience like others, she still felt God's presence. "I saw Jesus walking around in the monstrance."

Since Steubenville, Ava feels like she "hasn't stopped living [her] faith." She commented that she tries to read her Bible daily, even when it gets hard. "Whenever I drive in my car, I listen to praise and worship. I just dropped all the country music. I like this music [...] I have also made myself go to youth group every week, because we have adoration."

She makes sure to go to Mass every Sunday and goes to confession when she does not. Ava strives to live out her faith increasingly, despite the difficulties, and even when she fails.

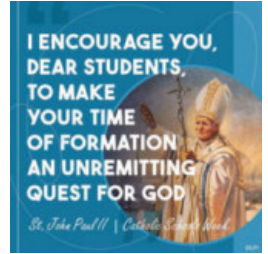

Our parish was organized in 1917, by a small group of Polish people under the patronage of Our Lady of Lourdes. They met in a remodeled hotel previously known as the Antler's Hotel. At that time there was no Catholic parish located on the west side of the river with three on the east side in Little Falls.

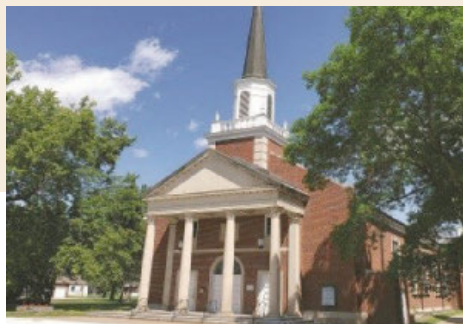

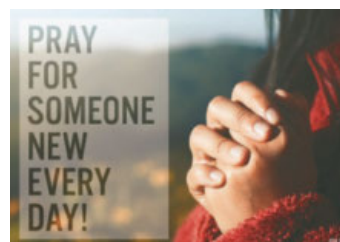

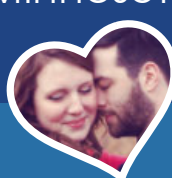
