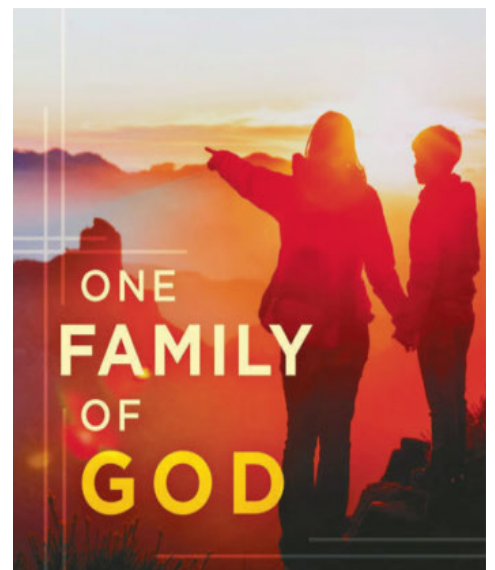
Dear Father John,

VIRTUS, PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN FOR ADULTS

All employees of the Archdiocese (including clergy and consecrated laymen and laywomen) and all volunteers (including Vacation Bible School volunteers), over the age of 18, who have substantial contact with children and/or youth, in the school or church, are required to submit a background check and attend VIRTUS, the awareness session of the Archdiocese's child abuse program, Protecting God's Children for Adults, prior to working with children or youth.

All VIRTUS sessions are online, **however, this will be changing soon.** You will need to register an account with our Archdiocese and complete the background check and paperwork.

1. Click on "First-Time Registrant"
2. Click on "Begin the registration process."
3. On the "Select" organization drop-down menu, select "Kansas City in Kansas (Archdiocese)".
4. Create a User ID and Password, complete the profile information, and select a class to attend.
5. You must complete the background check and paperwork at this point.
6. Plan to have 20-30 minutes to register and complete the online paperwork. The system will not allow you to save what you start working on and return at a later time to complete. **DO NOT USE THE BACK BUTTON ON THE ADDRESS BAR, OR IT WILL DELETE YOUR PROGRESS AND YOU WILL HAVE TO START OVER.**
7. VIRTUS Registration **MUST BE DONE ON A COMPUTER**, not a tablet, iPad or phone. The system will not allow these devices due to security reasons.
8. Complete training Protecting God's Children® Online Awareness Session 3.0 Online, this takes about 3 hours.
9. Be aware you will have monthly training bulletins emailed to you that take about 2-5 minutes to complete. You must stay current to volunteer.

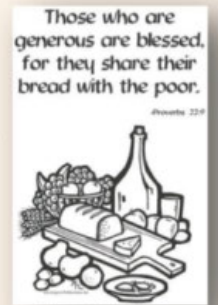

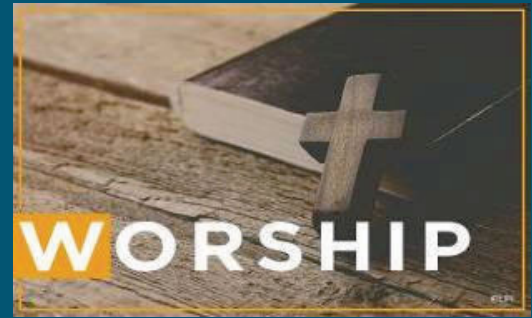

CUENTO NÚMERO 36

Cristo es un buen maestro: ¡el mejor de todos!
(Mateo 9, 28-29)

Cuando éramos chicos, en las escuelas argentinas, se nos hablaba de Sarmiento como del "maestro de América" y, con fervor juvenil, cantábamos el himno compuesto en su honor. Dejando en claro los valores de este prócer, también tuvimos otros maestros (para mí fue especial "la señorita de tercer grado": muy linda y dulce, de ésas de las que los chicos nos enamoramos a primera vista...). También se llama "maestros" a Von Karajan y a Toscanini. Otros, los "burreros", dieron ese título a Ireneo Leguisamo y, para los amantes de los "fierros" Fangio fue el titular de toda maestría. ¿Quién podrá dudar de que Sócrates fue un maestro en el arte de filosofar? Y es verdad que cada uno de los nombrados tiene "magisterio" en sus temas y áreas. Pero el cuento de hoy se refiere a otro tipo de maestro. ¿Largamos...?

Había una vez un maestro llamado Jesús. ¡Era todo un hombre que nos enseñó a vivir bien la vida de los hombres, mostrándonos cómo era la vida de Dios! Era modelo de humanidad. Pero en él se dio el caso único e irreplicable de que también era Dios, y su Palabra nos enseñó a vivir como Dios vive. Esto no es cosa fácil, no para él, para quien nada es difícil, sino para nosotros, que a duras penas sabemos deletrear la vida de los hombres y balbucear "humanidades", como para que nos pongan en el brete de aprender a vivir "divinidades" y a comportarnos como Dios se porta. Sin embargo, para esto vino Cristo al mundo: se hizo hombre para que nos hiciéramos como Dios.

Este extraño maestro pone todo patas para arriba. ¿Es sensato enseñar que los últimos serán los primeros y los primeros, los últimos, en un mundo competitivo en que los papas dan a sus hijos "las armas" para vivir, como si la vida fuera un puro y permanente combate?

En mi matemática, el primero es el primero y el último, el último, y que me dejen de jorobar. Jesús-Maestro enseñó, desde su cátedra escolar (pues él fundó una escuela de vida), que hay que negarse a sí mismo y tomar la cruz. ¿Y el valor y la dignidad de la persona humana? ¿Debemos negar nuestra identidad de cabezas de la creación? ¿Debemos aceptar el sufrimiento, cuando toda la ciencia nos ofrece elementos para atenuar los dolores, y cuando el sufrimiento, tal como la palabra y su contenido suenan, es un mal en sí" ¿Quiere este maestro graduar masoquistas que se complace en llorar? Es evidente que no, pero en su enseñanza nos dijo que los que lloran serían consolados, lo cual reclamaría llorar a moco tendido para recibir consuelos regrandes. ¿No debemos crecer y dejar de portarnos como niños malcriados, para llegar a la madurez humana a la que todo hombre, por vocación, está llamado y a la que tiende naturalmente?

Entonces, ¿por qué debo hacerme "como niño" para entrar en el Reino de los cielos?

Dicen que para muestra, basta un botón, pero lo antedicho no es nada frente a esto: -Al que te pegue en la mejilla, pole la otra, ¡No...! ¡Me resisto a permitir la existencia de sádicos que buscan que me presente como objeto de sus agresiones!

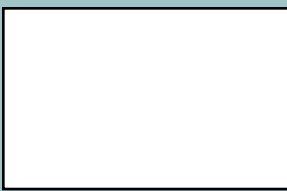

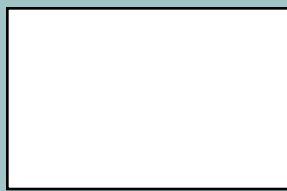


