VIRTUS, PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN FOR ADULTS

All employees of the Archdiocese (including clergy and consecrated laymen and laywomen) and all volunteers (including Vacation Bible School volunteers), over the age of 18, who have substantial contact with children and/or youth, in the school or church, are required to submit a background check and attend VIRTUS, the awareness session of the Archdiocese's child abuse program, Protecting God's Children for Adults, prior to working with children or youth.

All VIRTUS sessions are online, **however, this will be changing soon**. You will need to register an account with our Archdiocese and complete the background check and paperwork.

Go to: <https://www.virtusonline.org>.



1. Click on "First-Time Registrant"
2. Click on "Begin the registration process."
3. On the "Select" organization drop-down menu, select "Kansas City in Kansas (Archdiocese)".
4. Create a User ID and Password, complete the profile information, and select a class to attend.
5. You must complete the background check and paperwork at this point.
6. Plan to have 20-30 minutes to register and complete the online paperwork. The system will not allow you to save what you start working on and return at a later time to complete. DO NOT USE THE BACK BUTTON ON THE ADDRESS BAR, OR IT WILL DELETE YOUR PROGRESS AND YOU WILL HAVE TO START OVER.
7. VIRTUS Registration MUST BE DONE ON A COMPUTER, not a tablet, iPad or phone. The system will not allow these devices due to security reasons.
8. Complete training Protecting God's Children® Online Awareness Session 3.0 Online, this takes about 3 hours.
9. Be aware you will have monthly training bulletins emailed to you that take about 2-5 minutes to complete. You must stay current to volunteer.

The Peter's Pence Collection has a long tradition as a sign that Catholics around the world are joined in support of the Holy Father.

A Concrete Sign of Mercy

The year 2020 united the whole world in suffering as the COVID-19 pandemic took millions of lives and created widespread economic hardship due to the closure of nonessential businesses. In Lebanon, the hardship of the pandemic was compounded by a catastrophic explosion of a warehouse at the port in Beirut on August 4, 2020. The blast killed more than 200 people and injured and displaced thousands more.

With funds collected through the Peter's Pence Collection, the Holy Father provided an immediate response of €250,000 to the Church in Lebanon, which made medical care, temporary shelter, and other basic needs available to victims through the efforts of Caritas Lebanon, Caritas Internationalis, and sister organizations of Caritas. Donations to the Peter's Pence Collection support not only the activities of the Roman Curia that assist the pope in the exercise of his ministry but also

CUENTO NUMERO 39

Jesús, látigo en mano, pega duro y parejo (Juan 2, 13-16)

Les voy a contar un cuento inspirado en lo que Jesús hizo en el templo, hace casi dos mil años. Por supuesto, como un cuento es un trabajo literario en el que juega la imaginación del autor, añadiré -de mi propia cosecha- algunas cosas que "podrían" haber sucedido en aquellos tiempos.

Cuando se aproximaba la fiesta de Pascua, Jesús subió al templo y se llevó una gran sorpresa (¡y bronca de primera!). Todo era un lío: cambistas con dinero en dólares, yens, pesetas, oro... Venta de animales para las ofrendas, incienso, velas... ¡de todo! Estoy seguro de que también, como en el Santuario de los santuarios que era, habrán vendido estampitas de Isaías, algún pedazo bendito de las tablas de la Ley, postales con la foto de Caifás y otros líderes religiosos, agua bendita del Jordán, casetes con las últimas palabras de los Macabeos, banderines de los scouts del templo, folletos ilustrativos, una réplica ("en chiquito") de los rollos del Pentateuco, vidas de santos y mil cosas más. Y mucho de esto no era malo, ni entonces ni ahora, pero en tiempos de Jesús, el templo se había convertido en un Shopping Center y, en rigor de verdad, no era eso, sino "casa de oración", lugar donde Dios habitaba para hablar con su pueblo.

¿Cuál fue la reacción del "dulce Jesús"? Más amarga que mate amarga o té de carqueja.... ¡Qué rabia le vino al Señor! Nunca lo habíamos visto así.

Ahí no más agarró un rebenque nuevo y empezó a dar lonjazos a diestra y siniestra, sobre los dueños de los kioscos, los vendedores ambulantes, los puestos de choripán, las mesas donde estaban las divisas y los representantes del Mercado de Liniers con sus vaquillonas, bueyes, corderitos, cabritos y otros bichos.

No quedó ni la sombra de esa gente, porque corrieron más veloces que Schumacher con su nueva Ferrari.

No creamos que Jesús daba latigazos silenciosos. Mientras repartía duro y parejo a quienes merecían los latigazos, gritaba, exasperado: - ¡Manga de ladrones, pervertidos y desgraciados! Qué se han credo, hijos de Roque Féyer, piratas como Morgan y más mentirosos que Selim-Hessed Fahrhad un compañero "turco" que tuve en el Instituto "Guillermo Rawson" de Nazaret, que le robaba dinero a su padre para comprar puchos, tragos y droga...

Jesús hizo ese día gimnasia para un mes, demostrando que era fuerte y que tenía mano dura, cuando quería y era necesario. Y la horda de vendedores ambulantes sin permiso le gritaba, a su vez: - ¿Quién te dio bola en este entierro? ¿Te crees la Madre Teresa de Calcuta, que tratas de darnos lecciones de santidad? ¿A quién perjudicamos? ¿Acaso los fieles devotos no tienen que comprar el corderito para la Pascua? ¿O acaso estás contra las fiestas de precepto?

¡Hereje...! ¡Mira que tenemos amigos en la Municipalidad, y los impuestos están todos en regla! ¡Insensible! Bastante nos costó obtener la concesión para los puestitos, que ahora nos tiras abajo la estantería.... Los mayoristas se van a aprovechar de nuestra desgracia y van a aumentar los precios, y no podremos renovar el stock...Podríamos conseguir unos corderitos congelados Swift, pero doña Rosa y las amas de casa los quieren fresquitos. ¡Raja, loco, o la vas a pasar mal...!

A todo esto, Jesús ya se había cansado de repartir boyos y no le quedaba nada más que romper. Además, se había quedado un poco distónico y no podría predicar por unos días, si seguía forzando la garganta. El celo del templo lo consumía y quería las cosas claras. A esta casa de oración no se iba "ombliguito al aire", como lo había notado en algunos turistas. No podía tampoco darse el equívoco de que nos acusaran de simonía (una cosa fea que invento un tal Simón el mago, " de la cual habla el capítulo 8º de los Hechos de los Apóstoles), corriendo el riesgo de que nos tilden de "traficantes de lo sagrado", y dar pie a que no se distinga entre los lugares os de oración y los "boliches" de Villa Gesell.

Pero, aunque Jesús se agarró una mufa de padre y señor nuestro, no era un violento, sino un hombre tierno.

Un mes después de la muerte del Maestro, tuve que ir a Jerusalén para organizar un tour "religioso-cultural" a Tierra Santa, desde

Buenos Aires y con una opción posterior: una semana en la Costa azul, con visita incluida al Casino de Montecarlo, o diez días haciendo oración en los santuarios de Fátima y Lourdes.

Como les decía, hablando con Simón-Pedro, me conto que después de esa trifulca en el templo y cuando el Señor se hubo calmado, las lágrimas comenzaron a correrle por las mejillas. Pero no eran lágrimas de rabia, sino de compasión. Lloró amargamente por los que cambiaban dólares, vendían hamburguesas, pollitos y corderos, bendiciones papales, incienso y todos los "productos sacros" de los que hablé al comienzo. Lloró por quienes desaprovechaban los bienes de Dios, cambiándolos por menudencias que no poseían valor alguno.

Un día después, cuando se le fueron el enojo y la tristeza, Jesús volvió a ser el mismo de siempre. Hasta recuerdo -me lo conto Pedro... - que le confeso: - ¡Soy muy chinchudo... Voy a tener que rezar más pidiendo a Dios un poco de paciencia...!

Si bien hay que tener celo por las cosas de Dios y el desprecio de su gloria es algo pasoso, hay que sentir, al mismo tiempo compasión por las miserias de los hombres. Por supuesto que hay "enjos buenos", y el de Jesús lo fue.

Además, si vas a Roma, puedes comprar una bendición papal y medallitas, pero sabiendo que Dios es más grande que eso, y poniendo tu confianza solo en su misericordia y su poder.
