EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP

WHAT JESUS DOESN'T SAY "If Jesus wanted us to (fill in the blank), he would have said so."

We hear this argument applied to every controversial topic under the sun — and even some not-so -controversial topics, too. Whenever someone is trying to make a case for a decision they have already made, they call in Jesus' scriptural silence on the matter as their expert, unimpeachable witness.

And sure, there's much Jesus doesn't talk about in the Gospels. But by this logic, we would have to assume that Jesus doesn't care, for instance, if we drive well over the speed limit (he doesn't discuss cars and highways in the Bible) or what we do online (he never mentions the Internet or websites at all!), when we know that certainly is just not the case.

Like the scholar of the Jewish law who challenges Jesus to

define who exactly his "neighbor" is, we can argue semantics all we want. But if we rest in prayer and look deep into our hearts, we know what path we need to take, and it's usually not the easy one.

I find that I do this plenty in wavs that are far more subtle. I lament that the situation facing me is not sufficiently "black and white." I become frustrated by the shades of moral grev and toss up my hands, claiming I don't know what the right answer is, insisting that I can't be blamed for the ramifications of whatever decision I make.

What I need to be doing in these situations is asking God for His guidance, even if it makes me nervous. I need to be like the scholar. He was brave enough to ask, even though I think he knew he wouldn't particularly like the answer. Let's strive for that same courage.

VIRTUS. PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN FOR ADULTS

All employees of the Archdiocese (including clergy and consecrated laymen and laywomen) and all volunteers (including Vacation Bible School volunteers), over the age of 18, who have substantial contact with children and/or youth, in the school or church, are required to submit a background check and attend VIRTUS, the awareness session of the Archdiocese's child abuse program, Protecting God's Children for Adults, prior to working with children or youth.

All VIRTUS sessions are online, however, this will be changing soon. You will need to register an account with our Archdiocese and complete the background check and paperwork. Go to: https://www.virtusonline.org.



- 1. Click on "First-Time Registrant"
- 2. Click on "Begin the registration process."
- 3. On the "Select" organization drop-down menu, select "Kansas City in Kansas (Archdiocese)".
- 4. Create a User ID and Password, complete the profile information, and select a class to attend.
- 5. You must complete the background check and paperwork at this point.
- 6. Plan to have 20-30 minutes to register and complete the online paperwork. The system will not allow you to save what you start working on and return at a later time to complete. DO NOT USE THE BACK BUTTON ON THE ADDRESS BAR, OR IT WILL DELETE YOUR PROGRESS AND YOU WILL HAVE TO START OVER.
- 7. VIRTUS Registration MUST BE DONE ON A COMPUTER, not a tablet, iPad or phone. The system will not allow these devices due to security reasons.
- 8. Complete training Protecting God's Children® Online Awareness Session 3.0 Online, this takes about 3 hours.
- 9. Be aware you will have monthly training bulletins emailed to you that take about 2-5 minutes to complete. You must stav current to volunteer.



BASEHOR ADORATION CHAPEL GAINS NATIONAL ATTENTION

BASEHOR — As the National Eucharistic
Revival initiative launches across the
United States, a eucharistic adoration
chapel within the archdiocese has earned
special distinction as an intriguing travel
destination.

In an article in the May 27 edition of Our Sunday Visitor, the Our Lady, Queen of the Holy Angels Adoration Chapel at Holy Angels Parish, Basehor, was named one of the "top 10 destinations devoted to the Blessed Sacrament." The list includes shrines, basilicas, a cathedral and a retreat center.




