

### Light and Darkness

As the flashlights came on and our K-2 students began singing "This Little Light of Mine", it became immediately clear that there was a different level of energy. It was the first time since 2019 that we have had an in-person concert at the school, and our students had an undeniable excitement that came out in word and song. Mrs. Laust brought back a "Lessons and Carols" theme, framing the musical pieces beautifully within the Christmas narrative. And she once again put together a program that was both memorable and high-quality. This was her 41st year directing a Christmas performance with students!! The concerts were broken into multiple showings, with separate times for Grades K-2 and 3-6. With almost 115 kids enrolled in the school, and a substantially higher number of parents and family members in attendance, multiple shows helped to spread out the crowd and avoid over packing the gym. Celebrating together was joyous, and the performances of the children pointed to a hope-filled mystery, the light shining through the darkness.

Our students hope for another round of activities and events as we look ahead to Catholic Schools Week, starting the last weekend of January and going into the first week of February. With so much uncertainty still this school year, we haven't made any definitive plans for Catholic Schools Week. But our students continue to look forward with that optimism and hope that seems to come more easily in children. We are thankful every day for our teachers, staff, parents and volunteers who make St. Joseph Parish School everything that it is. 
