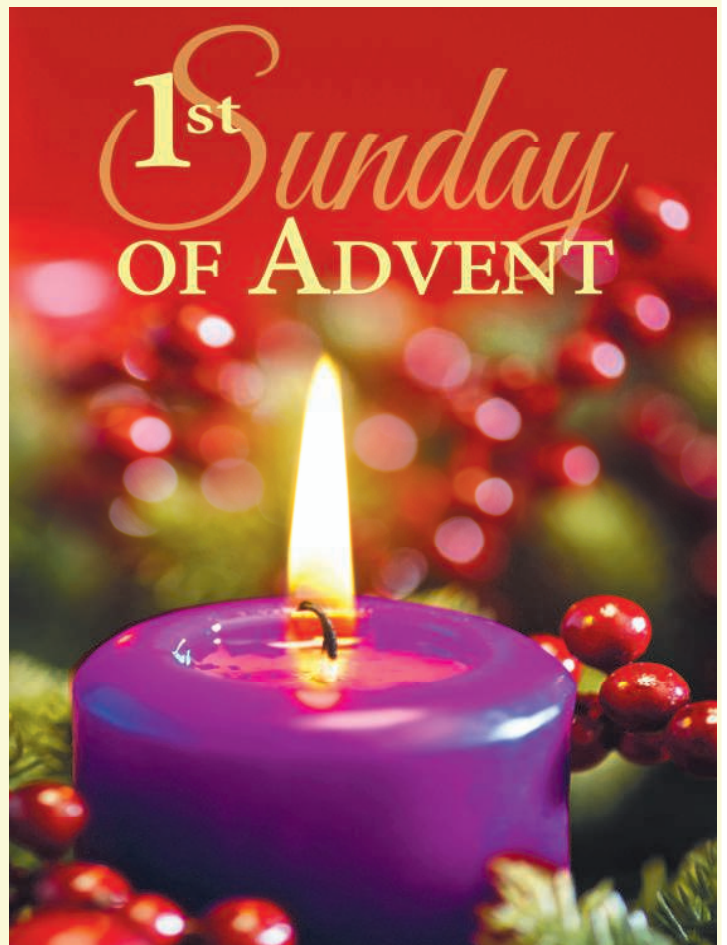

•There will be a Reconciliation Service at Immaculate Heart next Sunday, December 9, at 3:00 pm. Many priests from around the area will be available to hear confessions. Prepare for Advent and receive the most blessed gift of all—God's loving forgiveness.

•It is that time of year again when we inform you of our daily Mass cancellation policy. Daily Mass cancellation due to winter weather conditions will follow the Pequot Lakes School closing. If Pequot Lakes Schools are closed or two hours late, there will be no daily Mass at either church that day (because Fr. Blake resides in the Pequot Lakes school district). If Crosby-Ironton Schools close or have a two hour late start on a Wednesday or Friday, even if Pequot Lakes Schools are not closed or having a late start, there will not be daily Mass at St. Emily's that day.
