

Reflections for the Baptism of the Lord—Human beings tend to form groups, from families and communities, to social and political groups. There are many benefits to having common values and expectations. There is also a "downside." Groups by their nature set up and "us and them" situation in which the "them" is usually regarded as bad if not evil. Religious groups are particularly inclined to regard other groups as being on the wrong track and in need of conversion. Even the early Church struggled with this issue and Paul reminded them that it is not the group one belongs to that matters. It is the actions of the individual. How do you judge others- by the group they belong to or by the way they live their life?
