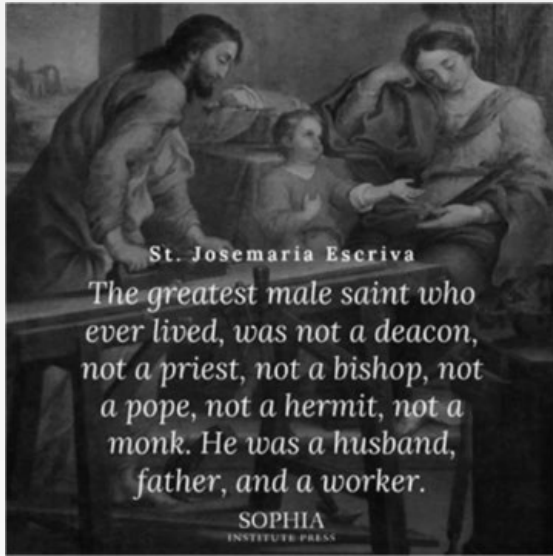

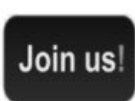
The Respect Life Ministry meeting will be Thursday, June 16, after the daily Mass at Immaculate Heart.
