Excerpts from the Lectionary for Mass #2001, 1998, 1970 CCD.

A message from Fr. David~

So, this is it, my first bulletin column. I've written many columns in my time as pastor. I see it as another way to reach out and guide my flock. I especially focus on the spiritual life in my columns and also practical matters and things I and parish staff are organizing or planning for you. Funny fact, just in the last 11 years (I did some research and the math proves. BTW I'm horrible at math, the whole counting backwards 7 from 100, I fail miserably) I have penned more total words than what is contained in the entire Bible (I'm pretty proud of that).

And so I begin my time in Crosslake and Emily with a quote that I hope will define my life, my work, my passion and these are not my words, but they come from a priest named Jean-Baptiste Henri Lacordaire. He was a French ecclesiastic, preacher, journalist, theologian and political activist. He re-established the Dominican Order in post-revolutionary France. Lacordaire was reputed to be one of the greatest pulpit orators of the nineteenth century. He lived from 1802-1861. Quote:

"To live in the midst of the world with no desire for its pleasures; to be a member of every family, yet belonging to none; to share all sufferings; to penetrate all secrets, to heal all wounds; to daily go from men to God to offer Him their homage and petitions; to return from God to men to bring them His pardon and hope; to have a heart of fire for charity and a heart of bronze for chastity; to bless and to be blest forever. O God, what a life, and it is yours, O Priest of Jesus Christ! Amen."

Talk show host Johnny Carson would have an illustration inserted in between segments that always said "more to come". You will notice that I will always end my bulletin column with this phrase. And so today I close with this because there will be "more to come", much more. Please take the time to read my column every week. I write it for you and for your spiritual edification. I hope and pray that I will be with you for a full term as your pastor, at least 10 years and maybe more. Next week I will tell you a little bit more about me.

- •Before each daily Mass there will be a recitation of the Angelus at 8:00 am and the rosary will be lead at 8:05 am.


