A message from Fr. David~

It is good to be here in Crosslake and Emily. I am your new pastor, Fr. David Forsman. I am planning on using this column today to convey some personal information about myself and my priestly ministry. First, I am 51 years old. Born in Duluth to Dennis and Kathy Forsman of Proctor, MN. I was raised in Proctor and went to Church and elementary school at St. Rose in Proctor, MN. I have 5 sisters and one brother. I am the second oldest (girl, boy, girl, boy, girl, girl, girl). My father died from Alzheimer's in November of 2016. My mother is still alive, she is 77 and she lives at home in Proctor with one of my sisters who is Developmentally Disabled and a 48 year-old adult. (Please pray for my mother and sister, they are going through some hard times right now.)

I have been a priest for 21 years. My first assignment as a priest was at Queen of Peace in Cloquet, St. Francis in Carlton, Sts. Mary and Joseph in Sawyer, and I believe the fourth one was called the Little Flower Chapel (on the Indian Reservation outside of Cloquet). My second assignment was at Holy Rosary in Aurora, St. John's in Biwabik and Queen of Peace in Hoyt Lakes. My third assignment was only one parish with a school, Immaculate Conception in Pine City. My last assignment was at St. James in Aitkin, Our Lady of Fatima in Garrison, Holy Family in Hillman, Holy Family in McGregor, and Our Lady of Fatima in McGrath. All totaled that's 15 parishes, now 17, with Immaculate Heart and St. Emily's. There are 81 parishes in the Diocese I have served in 21% of them. The amount of time I have spent in each of these 4 assignments is 2,4,4, and 11 years. I hope to be here for 10-12 years.

Before I was a priest, I attended seminary at Immaculate Heart of Mary Seminary in Winona, MN, for my undergraduate degree in philosophy from 1989-1993. I went to Mount St. Mary's Seminary in Emmitsburg, MD, for 8 weeks in '93 and had to return home to Proctor on sick-leave. I returned in 1994 to the St. Paul Seminary for a year of studies before I went on leave of absence for discernment for 2 years working and living in the Twin Cities. I worked in a couple of group homes and I drove a morning school bus route. I made my return to seminary for another year in St. Paul and did the Teaching Parish Program in Pequot Lakes and Nisswa with Fr. George Zeck in 1999-2000. I also spent a semester in the Holy Land with the Seminary Program. I was ordained a Transitional Deacon in 2000, then a priest of God on June 18th, 2001, the first ordination of Bishop Dennis Schnurr.

I was born November 18th, 1970. I was 30 when I was ordained a priest. I have two sisters that live in Proctor and my only brother and my mother. I have one sister that lives in Chanhassen, MN. The oldest and the youngest sisters live in Frederick and Gaithersburg, MD. If you are tempted to think a Priest's family must be perfect, it is not! I have relationship issues with some and have not spoken with some for many years. There is a bit of fault to go around and I need to own more responsibility but that takes time and time flies.
