

Announcing two new confession times. There will be confession before Sunday morning mass in Crosslake from 7:45-8:15am, this in addition to the current 3-3:45pm time before the 4pm Mass at Immaculate Heart. I am also announcing a new time for St. Emily's. Saturday morning from 10:30-11:15am will be the confession time there. The current time of Wednesday morning after the daily mass was not reaching a wide enough audience in my opinion. However, for anyone who wishes to go to confession after any morning mass (or before for that matter) it's only a matter of asking me. Review of Confession times:

Another opportunity for both parishes will be the First Saturday Devotion that will begin on the 3rd of September. These First Saturday Masses will be at St. Emily's in Emily because of the confession schedule. Those from Crosslake will want to take advantage of the First Saturday Mass even though it will not be in their parish. The morning begins at 9:45am with a rosary and prayers for the intentions of Pope Francis. Mass is held at 10am and confessions after that around 10:30am. Those who participate at First Saturday Devotion (and attend to this devotion 5 months in succession) receive a plenary indulgence (complete and full remission of any and all temporary punishment for you or a soul in purgatory). This is promised to you by Mary and the Church and it is a gracious gift for those who receive it. Our Lady of Fatima spoke about the First Saturday Devotion, she said to the seer Lucia:

"I promise to assist at the hour of death with all the graces necessary for the salvation of their souls...all those who for five months, on the first Saturday, go to Confession, receive Communion, say five decades of the Rosary, and keep me company for fifteen minutes meditating on the mysteries of the Rosary, with the purpose of making reparation to me."

The five first Saturdays correspond to the five kinds of offenses and blasphemies committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary:

- Blasphemies against her Immaculate Conception;
- Blasphemies against her virginity;
- Blasphemies against her divine maternity, at the same time refusing to accept her as the Mother of all men;
- Publicly instilling indifference, contempt and even hatred toward this Immaculate Mother in the hearts of children;
- Insulting her directly in her sacred images.

The Five First Saturday Devotion is one of the principal points of the Fatima message. It centers on the urgent need for mankind to offer reparation and expiate for the many injuries that the Immaculate Heart of Mary suffers from the hands of both impious and indifferent men.

On the First Saturday during five consecutive months, the devotion consists of:

- Going to Confession,
- Receiving the Sacrament of Holy Communion,
- Saying five decades of the Rosary,
- Meditating for 15 minutes on the mysteries of the Rosary.
