How to "pray" the Rosary not just "say" the Rosary.

The idea is to **meditate** while you are saying the words of the rosary, more particularly the "Hail Mary's". Meditation seems like a difficult thing but at the heart of it is imagination. With the Mysteries of the Rosary that means imagining you are in the Mystery, taking part of or observing what is going on in this event. Then it means adoring, thanking, or praising God for what you are experiencing and the grace it provides.

I know you can do this because we are all imaging things throughout the day. I am constantly thinking about things and then "imaging" what I will do with this information. Just today I was given the information that the garden behind the church in Crosslake was going to have to move because of drainage issues we are experiencing. I first had some thoughts, which then changed when I saw what was possible and impossible. Then seeing where these flowers and plants could go, I imagined them there (in that place) and then I could see that my previous ideas were not valid, but now they were aligned with what was truly possible. Another example: When I think of a work project that needs doing, I can further imagine each step, each tool, each move I have to make to accomplish the task. We all do this. But we don't all do it while we are praying the Rosary.

First of all, one needs to slow down. Have more of a silent, still posture before the Lord. We don't run in Church. Your brain needs to slow down during the Rosary. This is hard because it is not what we are used to while praying the Rosary.

Second, we need to recall what the Mystery of the Rosary is in as much detail as possible. Now for me this means remembering what I know from scripture and sacred tradition. Let me give an example from the third Joyful Mystery, The Nativity.

The angels above singing praise, calling the shepherds to worship. It was night there and there was a bright star in the sky. The Holy Family was keeping warm by the animal's breath. Mary gave birth to the Son of God and she wrapped Him in swaddling clothes and laid Him in a manger. And the shepherds adored the beautiful boy, the infant Jesus, the Son of God. And the Angels sang "Glory to God in the highest and peace upon the earth."

The emotions surrounding the Nativity were many and varied. Relief to find a place to stay. Joy at giving birth and seeing Jesus for the first time. Gratitude for the gift of Mary and Jesus' health and safe delivery. Wonder at the angels and shepherd's attention. Peace that it was over, but anxiety about what was just beginning.

Next week one more point about meditation with the Rosary. **More to come...**

St. Rose of Lima | August 23

Born Isabel Flores de Olivia in April 1586 in Lima, Peru to Spanish colonists, Saint Rose of Lima took the name Rose at her confirmation in 1597. Even as a child,

St. Rose was dedicated to Christ. She took a vow of chastity even though her parents wished her to marry. She fasted many times a week and permanently abstained from meat. Eventually her parents gave in and allowed her to join the Third Order of St. Dominic, although she was not permitted to live in a convent. St. Rose undertook severe penances, allowing herself only two hours of sleep a night in order to have more time to pray. She also cared for the sick and hungry and sold her beautiful embroidery and fine lace, as well as the flowers she grew, to help raise funds for the poor. She died at the age of 31 on August 24, 1617. Pope Clement X canonized her in 1671, she was the first saint of the New World. born in the Americas. St. Rose of Lima is the patron saint of Latin America and the Philippines.
