GOSPEL - MK 14:1—15:47

The Passover and the Feast of Unleavened Bread
 were to take place in two days' time. So the chief
 priests and the scribes were seeking a way to arrest
 him by treachery and put him to death. They said,

(C) **"Not during the festival, for fear that there may be a riot among the people."**

When he was in Bethany reclining at table in the
 house of Simon the leper, a woman came with an
 alabaster jar of perfumed oil, costly genuine
 spikenard. She broke the alabaster jar and poured it
 on his head. There were some who were indignant.

(C) **"Why has there been this waste of perfumed oil? It could have been sold for more than three hundred days' wages and the money given to the poor."**

 him, alleging,

(C) **"We heard him say, 'I will destroy this temple made with hands and within three days I will build another not made with hands.'"**

What evil has he done?" They only shouted the louder,
 (C) **"Crucify him."** The soldiers led him away ...

They clothed him in purple and, weaving a crown of
 thorns, placed it on him. They began to salute him with,

(C) **"Hail, King of the Jews!"**

... Those passing by

reviled him, shaking their heads and saying,

(C) **"Aha! You who would destroy the temple and rebuild it in three days, save yourself by coming down from the cross."** Likewise the chief priests, with the scribes, mocked him among themselves and said,

(C) **"He saved others; he cannot save himself. Let the Christ, the King of Israel, come down now from the cross that we may see and believe."**
