From Archbishop Gullickson . . .

The Sacrament of Penance

True to my promise, I want to offer a thought or two on the first of my proposed topics for the weeks ahead. As you may know, for those observing the old liturgical calendar we find ourselves already in what is sometimes called “pre-lent”. This was, and I think rightly so, a period for people to get themselves ready by making a good confession ahead of Ash Wednesday and the 40 days of Lent proper. That is the sense of the old English name for Mardi Gras or Fat Tuesday (called “fat” because of the eating of all sorts of fatty foods to clear them out of the pantry before the beginning of the Lenten fast). The old English name for that Tuesday was Shrove Tuesday and “shrove” or “shriven” was the old word for to confess your sins. Ash Wednesday still has its attraction for most Catholics, but in a rather superficial way. The practice of imposing ashes would be better lived if a good confession went before it.

Most of us attach going to confession during Lent to our preparation for fulfilling our Easter duty, which obliges us to receive Holy Communion worthily during the Easter season. The confession we are talking about in pre-lent could be just that (our confession before Easter Communion), but it is properly a way to open ourselves to living Lent to the full. Think of the priest’s words of admonition on Ash Wednesday: “Turn away from sin and be faithful to the Gospel!” Confession is about opening our hearts to the Lord, turning away from sin and Satan, to be with the Lord Who loves us and grants us the fulness of life in Him.

Here at St. Mary’s, we only have the one hour per week at 4pm on Saturdays scheduled for confessions. During Lent there will be some additional times in conjunction with Stations of the Cross. If I should make myself available at some other time in the confessional here in church, you will need to let me know when would be best. I plan to be in Salem for the day of Ash Wednesday. I would be glad to spend whatever time that day in the confessional. God Bless!
