From the Desk of Father Smith

Would we travel to see this revelation, go "out of our way" to experience God's coming as the wise men did?

A few weeks ago I had mentioned that I would be part of a trip to Israel and Italy in early February. With the rapid increase in COVID-19 cases around the world due to the latest variant, that trip has been postponed. I don't know if or when it will be rescheduled. So I guess I'll be here to enjoy February with all of you!

Running out of things to say after my travels, so you get another big picture. Epiphany Blessings to you!
