

Happy Easter! I hope you have had a blessed Holy Week. As we move now into this sacred and celebratory season of Easter, I'd encourage you to enjoy



the celebrations... but be careful not to overdo it. There's something that happens at times called "Solemnity Slump". I learned about it from the Handmaids who are the religious sisters I worked with in Duluth. Solemnity Slump is when you celebrate in a way that leaves you feeling tired... not restored... and generally is caused from over indulgence in "good" stuff that we normally don't do, but is good in small amounts. So, enjoy the great celebration of Easter, but don't give in to total gluttony or over indulgence. It makes for a better experience.

Next weekend we have 1st Communion at the Sunday Masses, and it is also the celebration of Divine Mercy. I had previously planned to be on retreat Sun. the 24th - Fri. 29th so I will be headed out of town shortly after the Masses next Sunday. Unfortunately, I won't be around to make it to any parties that day ②. However, I look forward to the special day with you.

People have already been asking about the Mass schedule... will I change it...? Let's just try this for a while. I'm going to assess things. Even though I was here before. I need some time to get a sense of what's best. So, if you ask me... I'll likely say... I don't know. It was a bit of an experiment during Covid, and now that we are coming out of Covid... let's let it ride... at least for a while. I do like the idea of being able to be present in both places for the day... rather than going back and forth Sunday.

There is a Divine Mercy Event at St. Francis in Brainerd on Sunday April 24th. It begins at 2:30 PM and entails a holy hour, confessions and adoration. Feel free to attend. To get the indulgence attached to Divine Mercy Sunday, you don't need to go to confession on the day of Divine Mercy... If you have gone in the 20 days before or will go 20 days after that will suffice. So, if you receive communion beginning on the eve of Divine Mercy, and confess your sins and pray for the Holy Father's intentions you are then able to do the specific things that the indulgence is attached to. See below:

First there are the usual or standard three conditions of sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion, and prayer for the intentions of Supreme Pontiff. Next, the specific conditions or "work" required on Divine Mercy Sunday: in any church or chapel, in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for a sin, even a venial sin, take part in the prayers and devotions held in honor of Divine Mercy or, in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed or reserved in the tabernacle, recite the Our Father and the Creed, adding a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus (for example: "Merciful Jesus, I trust in you!"). St. John Paul II not only declared Divine Mercy Sunday a universal feast of the Church, but in 2002 he attached a plenary indulgence to it. This made private revelation's promise "official" as "the Holy See institutionalized the Promise in the form of an Indulgence." The most special grace promised by our Lord for Mercy Sun-

day is nothing less than the equivalent of a complete renewal of baptismal grace in the soul: "complete forgiveness (remission) of sins and punishment. This is a pretty great gift which Jesus offers us on this Solemnity. So, take advantage of it if you can. Happy Easter. In Christ,
