

MESSAGE FROM DEACON DAN

Dear Parishioners,

Each diocese has a Director of the Permanent Diaconate. A brief summary of the duties of the director include: Oversee the training and formation of those discerning a vocation to the permanent diaconate; and ongoing formation, retreats and study opportunities for those already ordained as permanent deacons. There is more to it than that, but that is a brief description.

In the Diocese of Duluth, Deacon David Craig (Father Anthony's Dad) held that office for about 27 years. For the last eight years Deacon John Weiske was in that position. Deacon John officially retired at the end of May.

A couple months ago, Monday, March 28, 2022, Bishop Daniel Felton made the following announcement:

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

It is with great joy that I announce the Holy Spirit has called Deacon Daniel Goshey to be the next Director of the Permanent Diaconate, effective June 1, 2022. He will continue his assignment as a deacon in the Crosby and Garrison parishes. Deacon John Weiske will work with Deacon Dan to transition into the role. Deacon Dan was ordained into the diaconate on November 26, 2017. Deacon Dan brings to this position a deep love for the diaconate and his deacon brothers and their wives ...

May the blessings of our God fill the hearts of all of our deacons! (Note: This is a small portion of Bishop Daniel Felton's letter).

I welcome this appointment with incredible joy and enthusiasm! When I was in formation and discerning the diaconate myself, I imagined how wonderful it would be to serve in that position someday. To be a deacon to the deacons; a servant to the servants. Four and a half years later, the dream is coming true. Praise God! What does this mean for me as a servant in our Crosby and Garrison parishes? I will be spending more time in Duluth – at least weekly visits to my office in the diocesan Pastoral Center. I will still serve in many of the same ways I have been serving here in our parishes; however, I will not be around on weekends as much. I will probably only be available about two weekends per month during the "school year."

Some of you may also wonder how this might affect my job at the radio station. Since the diocesan position is only part time, I will still be working part time at the radio station. This will allow me to stay involved in a (so far 33 years long) career that I very much enjoy...and it will allow me to ensure that our Christmas programming is done properly! I'm not ready to give that up yet...nobody else would do it right.

I share the above information with you so that – when you see less of me in the future – you understand why. Please pray for me and for all permanent deacons. Pray also, that God will send us more. I will do my best to see to it they are trained well...by the grace of God. God bless,






