Dear Parishioners,

We celebrate Corpus Christi this weekend. We have been in ordinary time since the Monday after Pentecost, but next weekend will be the first time we wear green for a weekend Mass in quite some time. Today's solemnity is a chance to celebrate and reflect on our belief that Jesus is present in the Eucharist. There is a uniquely Catholic understanding of how Jesus is present, and this affects how we interact to the Eucharist. We treat the sacred species with reverence. We pray before the host in adoration, and we are careful to purify the vessels which Christ becomes present in. Protestants have a very different understanding of the Eucharist. There is quite a range of ways in which they understand the Eucharist. For some of them communion is merely a sign, there is no belief that this is Jesus. For others, they believe in a spiritual presence in the Eucharist, but not the physical presence. Jesus's presence comes to them through communion, but it isn't directly linked to the host. This is why they don't take time to purify vessels, and why they can throw away any 'left overs'. They have a different understanding of the Eucharist and a different theology. Their theology comes out of the reformation tradition which was a rejection of the ancient Catholic understanding of the Eucharist and the need for priests.

As Catholics we have a special regard for the Eucharist and therefore, our Eucharistic piety should support our belief. This is why we take time today to celebrate the Eucharist. This is why we do Eucharistic processions. This is why we have tabernacles, adoration, and golden chalices. It's all a way to show our love for Jesus in the Eucharist and to give thanks for this wonderful gift.

We have our priesthood ordination on Friday 5 PM, June 24th at the Cathedral. We will have 2 new priests. Father's Dan Hammer and Scott Padrnos will be our newest priests. Fr. Scott is having a Mass of thanksgiving Sunday June 26th at 2 PM at St. Christopher in Nisswa. If you would like to go to that, you are welcome. Dcn. Scott served here last summer, so many of you may know him. I will be going to the final vows for Sr. Magnificat and Sr. Mary Elizabeth who are part of the Handmaids of the Heart of Jesus. Sr. Magnificat is the superior in Duluth at their convent. It was part of the cluster where I was assigned during the last 2 years. The vows are at the Cathedral in New Ulm at 10 AM Sat. morning. It is open to the public for anyone who may want to go. Fr. George will cover the Sat. evening Mass on June 25th while I am away.

Next week (beginning Sunday evening the 26th of June), we have Totus Tuus. This is a week-long summer event for our youth. The morning sessions are 9 AM-2:30 PM for the younger students, and the evenings are 7-9 PM for the older students. Daily Mass time is moved for this week. It will be Mon.-Fri. at 11:30 AM at St. Joseph. There will be confessions at 11 AM each day. I will still have the Wed. 9 AM Mass at Our Lady of Fatima, and Fr. George will still do the 9 AM at OLF for 1st Friday.

I pray you have a Blessed Solemnity!

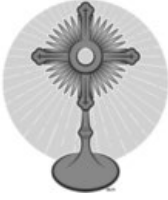
