Dear Parishioners,

I wanted to thank all those who helped put on and who attended the event at the new property last Sunday. I am grateful for the wonderful support I have here in this community.

Just to reiterate I mentioned this in last week's bulletin and at the Masses... I am asking parishioners if they can up their monthly giving by \$20, which works out to be about \$5 extra per week. This will help us meet our financial needs. I'm sure you all are feeling the pinch with inflation, and we are too. I've already switched my online giving to reflect that, and I would invite you to do the same if you are able.

We are trying to maintain the ministries we have and we are also interested in growing and developing more, but it all requires more involvement from volunteers, and more finances. Since I was here last, we have more staff and staff hours, which I believe are serving our parish cluster better, but it does mean our budget has been tighter these last few years.

Here are some things that are coming up. The youth garage sale is coming up July 21-22. This has been a good fundraiser for our youth in the past and we are hopeful that it will be again. Also a reminder that we have Fr. Phil Stokman at St. Joseph on July 30th at both Sunday Masses. There will be donuts after the 8:30 and a reception after the 10:30 for those wishing to greet him and get a first blessing. He's the first priest to be ordained from St. Joseph.

The Relationship's 101 event this Wed. is at 6 PM at the St. Joseph Church in the social Hall. Part of the evening will also be praise and worship which will be from 7-8 PM, anyone is welcome to join for that part of the evening. We are planning on having praise and worship as part of our faith formation this coming year, and to have it about once a month in the summer. The current schedule is: - July 19th 7-8

We'll try to remind you when they are coming up. This Wednesday. is the first open one 7-8 PM.

I would like to start saying the Angelus before the noon Mass on Tuesday's. We will make up little cards for people to use. It's a traditional prayer that is said by Catholics at 6 AM, Noon and 6 PM. It's a valuable thing to learn to pray this prayer.

Also, I haven't been in the habit of using the St. Michael prayer after the Saturday Mass at OLF. We have incorporated it at all the Masses, so I plan to start doing it after the final blessing at OLF as well (provided I remember).

I'd ask your prayers for several priests from our diocese who are needing a break for personal reasons or health issues as of late. In particular, Fr. Tim Lang, Fr. Justin Fish, Fr. Thomas Galarneault, Fr. Joel Hastings, Fr. Ben Hadrich, could all use some prayers. We do have some Indian priests who have arrived to help us fill in some of the gaps for now, but that is a temporary solution.
