

### FROM FATHER TIMOTHY CLOUTIER

#### **GOD'S COMMANDMENTS AND OUR HAPPINESS**

The revelation by God of the divine will for humanity, created in God's own image and likeness, is like the "user's manual" for human happiness.

Too many people, however, including many who consider themselves Christians, see the Ten Commandments, the Beatitudes, or any other difficult or challenging teaching of the Gospel as simply an "imposition" on their own judgment, their own personal freedom, and on their own self-determined pursuit of happiness. But, the reality is just the opposite, and it wouldn't hurt to remember the saying that, "if it doesn't work, read the instructions."

Rather than something externally and arbitrarily "imposed" on human nature, God's revealed will and law actually reveal the purpose and destiny of human nature as God the Creator intended it. Therefore, to follow God's will as it has been revealed is to pursue the only path that will lead to real happiness in this life and, more importantly, to eternal happiness in the next. To reject it is to reject God's will for our happiness in this life, and more importantly, eternal happiness in the next.

The Commandments and the demands of the Gospel challenge us all, but the degree of resistance on our part may reveal a deeper and more serious problem. So, in order to find out whether or not you see God's will for you in one way or in the other, ask yourself this simple question: "What would change in my daily behavior, choices, or in my lifestyle if there were no Commandments?"

#### A PRAYERFUL THOUGHT ON CHRISTIANITY

In the home it is kindness; In the business it is honesty;

In society it is courtesy; In work it is fairness;

Toward the unfortunate it is sympathy; Toward the weak it is help;

Toward the wicked it is resistance; Toward the strong it is trust;

Toward the penitent it is forgiveness; Toward the successful it is congratulation; And toward God it is reverence and obedience.

#### SCRIPTURE REFLECTIONS FOR NEXT SUNDAY JUNE 5TH, PENTECOST:

**Acts 2:1-11** Here is the Church's "birthday scene": the expression of one faith in many languages, all praising the one, true God, Creator and Redeemer of all.

**I Corinthians 12: 3b-7, 12-13** The metaphor of a body goes beyond a mere image; it expresses a spiritual reality, one that evokes expression in everyone putting their gifts and talents at the service of all, just as each of the members of our own physical body is coordinated in working for the good of the whole.

or **Romans 8:8-17** Just as light and darkness cannot coexist in the same place at the same time, so neither can sin and the indwelling in the soul of the Holy Spirit.

**St. John 20:19-23** Here is the commissioning given by Jesus to those members of his body, the Church, whom he would endow with his own power to forgive sins.

or **St. John 14:15-16, 23b-26** "The Father will love" and send "The Advocate, the Holy Spirit" to teach only those who keep the word spoken to us by the Lord Jesus.


