

THANK-YOU FOR THE PRIVILEGE OF SERVING

June 30 will be the last day of my six-year assignment as your Pastor. I want to take the opportunity to thank you for the warm welcome you've shown me, the prayerful and moral support you've given me, and the edifying example of Christian faith in life you've been for me. But, most of all, I want to thank you just for being you. Your goodness, your faith, your generous sharing of your gifts and of yourselves make me truly proud to count myself among those privileged few who have been able to claim the honor of being Pastor of Maternity of Mary Parish. It's not so much the tally of all that we've accomplished together, but how much we've grown in our Christian vocations. I would like to leave you with one last thought, to keep looking forward to all the possibilities and opportunities that lie ahead. Thank-you again, and, remember, you've only just begun.

THE INDISPENSIBLE IMPORTANCE OF FATHERHOOD

As I noted in my article in April of this year, my father was the single most important factor in my discernment of a vocation to the priesthood, without having mentioned or suggested it to me even once during my childhood and youth.

There have been numerous studies in recent years on the healthy developmental impact fathers have in the lives of children, whether they are biologically their own or adopted. A father in the home doesn't just provide stability and needed help with the practical matters of maintaining a household and raising children, but provides something much more enduring and important: a role model, and this at more than one level.

A self-possessed father figure provides a role model for boys of how to bring out the best in themselves in order to serve those whom they love. He sees in his father a role model of responsibility fulfilling tasks and duties, and of putting others ahead of himself. He learns from his dad how to do things that are useful around the house, allowing him to discover both abilities and activities he may pursue as he grows and finds himself.

A father in the home provides girls with the role model, critically needed in our day, of the character traits in a man who is caring, providing, gentle yet strong, both respectful of his wife and deserving of respect from her and from his children. She will someday apply, more or less unconsciously the traits she perceives in her dad to her male friends and eventually to the one she would choose as her life's partner and soul mate.

To all you who have been this and so much more to us, your children, thank-you, and may God richly rewards your fatherhood and the blessing you have been in our lives! HAPPY FATHER'S DAY!


