

FROM FATHER PHILIPPE VIGNERON

"What must I do to inherit eternal life?"

What a good question! Actually, it is the most important and appropriate question we can ask Jesus. That is the only reason why the Son of God was made man: "He became man so that we might become God". It is, however, surprising that only two persons, in the Gospel, asked that question. A scholar in the Gospel according to Luke (chap. X), a rich man in Matthew (XIX), Mark (X) and Luke (XVIII).

I would also like to draw to your attention the way this question is asked. He doesn't ask "what must I do to deserve eternal life?", or even to receive it, but "to inherit" eternal life. Again, I'm impressed by the quality and precision of the question. Of course, "eternal life" cannot be deserved: we are creatures, therefore, how could we do something that has an infinite value? But, if it is a heritage, it also means that it can only be given, if the legitimate owner dies. In other words, that man is implicitly saying that God needs to die, so we can inherit eternal life!

That scholar is definitely impressive. He is ready to welcome Jesus for who he is: the Savior of the World. Before we listen to the answer of Jesus, that I will comment on in the homily, I encourage you to spend some time to think about that question, and how it is formulated. Two questions to guide your prayer: how much do I really want to inherit eternal life above everything else? Do I realize, Jesus, God made man, was the only one who could have saved me?




