FROM FATHER PHILIPPE VIGNERON

"What do you want me to do for you?"

Last week, the disciples asked Jesus to teach them how to pray. Jesus told us that if we ask, we shall receive. This Sunday, someone from the crowd asks Christ to help him to get a share of his inheritance, but his prayer is not answered. Therefore, we can conclude that not all of our prayers will be answered in the way that we think they should. Perhaps we need to reexamine our prayer and what we are praying for.

The Gospel should help us to discern what would be a good prayer. We only need one thing: God; because only God suffices. God will never grant us anything that could lead us away from Him. Just remember that money, material goods in general, are good servants but bad masters. Everything that belongs to this World is vanity, unless it helps us to go to Heaven. Everything we do is vanity, unless it is according to God's will. That's how I understand these words of Qoheleth: "Vanity of vanities! All things are vanity!"

What do we really need? God himself – no more, no less. That is why Jesus promised us that the Father will give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him. I realize, writing these words, that I should ask much more often to be filled with the Holy Spirit.

For what purpose do we need the Holy Spirit? I like this answer, from the 4th Eucharistic Prayer: "That we might live no longer for ourselves but for him who died and rose again for us".

Holy Spirit, come and fill our hearts,

come and give us life, come and make us one, come and make us yours!


