FROM FATHER PHILIPPE VIGNERON

"Faith begins when God does not answer"

How many times did I hear a brother say he had lost faith, because he did not feel the presence of God anymore. He is probably wrong. It is especially when we don't feel His presence, that our faith is tested. When we feel the presence of God, we don't believe that He is there, we **know** it. When He grants us what we ask for in prayer, we know that He has heard us. We do not need faith. That is why, if God wants to increase our faith, He has to hide Himself; He has to delay his answer. I have to admit that it's difficult to accept, but logical.

A few key points might be helpful in this kind of situation. First, do not trust your feelings, they are often deceitful. Second, confess your sins, because sin does cloud your spiritual senses. Third, try to remember moments in your life when God clearly showed to you His presence and His goodness. Fourth, some passages of the Bible can be helpful, especially some Psalms. For example, Ps 34: "This poor one cried out and the Lord heard". Note that the psalmist does not say "He answered", but "He heard. Or Ps 22 the one Jesus prayed on the Cross. In the Gospel according to Mark, chapter 4 (35:41): Jesus sleeps and eventually calms the storm. Or, in chapter 9 (14:29) where you can find that beautiful prayer: "I do believe; help my unbelief!" Eventually, you can, of course, talk to a priest. We are here for you!

A Successful Spring Fling


