Hurried Excitement of the Shepherds!

“So the shepherds went with haste and found Mary and Joseph, and the baby, who was lying in a manger.” (Luke 2:16)

I am brought before “*hurried excitement of the shepherds*” this Christmas!

Although reference to the shepherds evokes a positive, pastoral image for the modern reader and underscores Jesus’ association with the line of David in the first century, shepherds were scorned as shiftless, dishonest people who grazed their flocks on others’ lands. Against this background, Luke develops Jesus’ connection with David and Bethlehem, and importantly, pictures Jesus as one sent to the lowly and outcast.

Despite the lowly estate of the shepherds, I am in wonder and amazement of the God who chooses the shepherds to receive the news of the Savior’s birth. What is equally admirable is that the shepherds—lowly as they are—join our Blessed Mother in their response: *they go in haste to see the Savior* (Luke 1:38).

We live in a *hurried context* today. But what are we in a hurry for—for things or for the Savior, for instant gratification or for a divine encounter, for the delights of the world or the Savior, for experience of immediacy or for the experience of eternity? Answering these will offer insight into where we are.

The shepherds go in haste to see the Savior. Their urgency and immediacy are for a divine encounter. The Evangelist tells us that after seeing “the child lying in the manger,” they return “glorifying and praising God for all the things they had heard and seen, which were just as they had been told” (Lk 2:20). They confirm the truth about the Son of God, they become “evangelizers in the fields,” and they bear witness to the Savior.

In the face of personal and global challenges, have we sensed an urgency for God? Then go after Him as Zacchaeus willing to return fourfold, or as the man who has found the pearl of great price, or as the woman who would not spare the costliest ointment to anoint Jesus because she has been loved much.

May the Incarnate Savior fill your heart with peace, Father Chinna

¡Me llevaron ante la “emoción apresurada de los pastores” esta Navidad!

Aunque la referencia a los pastores evoca una imagen pastoral positiva para el lector moderno y subraya la asociación de Jesús con la línea de David en el primer siglo, los pastores fueron despreciados como personas deshonestas e indolentes que pastaban sus rebaños en tierras ajenas. En este contexto, Lucas desarrolla la conexión de Jesús con David y Belén y, lo que es más importante, describe a Jesús como uno enviado a los humildes y marginados

A pesar de la humildad de los pastores, estoy maravillado y asombrado del Dios que elige a los pastores para recibir la noticia del nacimiento del Salvador. Lo que es igualmente admirable es que los pastores, humildes como son, se unen a nuestra Santísima Madre en su respuesta: *van apresurados a ver al Salvador* (Luke 1:38).

Vivimos en un contexto apresurado hoy. Pero, ¿por qué tenemos prisa, por las cosas o por el Salvador, por la gratificación instantánea o por un encuentro divino, por las delicias del mundo o del Salvador, por la experiencia de la inmediatez o por la experiencia de la eternidad? Responder a estos ofrecerá una idea de dónde estamos.

Los pastores se apresuran a ver al Salvador. Su urgencia e inmediatez son para un encuentro divino. El evangelista nos dice que después de ver “al niño acostado en el pesebre”, regresan “glorificando y alabando a Dios por todo lo que oyeron y vieron, que fueron tal como se les había dicho” (Lucas 2:20). Confirman la verdad sobre el Hijo de Dios, se convierten en “evangelizadores en el campo”, dando testimonio del Salvador.

Frente a los desafíos personales y globales, ¿hemos sentido una urgencia por Dios? Luego ve tras Él como Zaqueo dispuesto a regresar cuadruplicado (Lucas 19:8), o como el hombre que está dispuesto a vender todo lo que tiene para poseer la perla de gran precio (Mateo 13:46), o como la mujer que no perdonará el ungüento más caro porque ha sido amada mucho (Juan 12: 3).




