## BAPTISM: AN INVISIBLE GUARANTEE!

In our last preparatory session for the Sacrament of Baptism, one of the parents described Baptism as an <u>invisible guarantee</u> that God is always there to protect his child from all dangers. The father explained that he cannot be present to his child always and he cannot be watching over his child all the time, but he knows deep in his heart that through Baptism God assures that He will always be there.

What a marvelous way to describe the precious gift of God's *ownership and belovedness!* This is what gives us the courage to return home when we have gone astray, this is what stirs our hearts to love the ones who have hurt us, this is what restores us to original beauty when we have stained it by our choices for the less good, and this is what gives us the grace and humility to beg for God's mercy and long for his kindness.

God does it for us when His Son, though sinless, decides to lift us up by standing one among sinners to be baptized by John. With Pope Benedict, "let us consider the greatness of our God who "blends into the grey mass of sinners" to restore our original greatness and beauty. Let's contemplate the humility of our God who bends so low to carry us forward to love, freedom, and transformation" (*Jesus of Nazareth*, 16 p).

I will never forget the faces of those who stood with me in my weakness. There is something unimaginable happens within us. The unmerited grace of God, as it were, becomes fruitful for the first time in us because we are ready to partake of our sonship (& daughtership) in the Lord. It brings us to the Face of Mercy we have been hungering for so long and yet unwillingly have stayed in darkness mistaking it for light.

As we celebrate the Baptism of our Lord Jesus, let us renew our baptismal promises. May our renewal be intentional and bold; may 2022 help us begin again to live as *His sons and daughters!*

Dios lo hace por nosotros cuando Su Hijo, aunque sin pecado, decide levantarnos poniéndonos de pie entre los pecadores para ser bautizados por Juan. Con el Papa Benedicto, "consideremos la grandeza de nuestro Dios que "se confunde con la masa gris de los pecadores" para restaurar nuestra grandeza y belleza originales. Contemplemos la humildad de nuestro Dios que se inclina tan bajo para llevarnos hacia el amor, la libertad y la transformación" (Pope Benedict, *Jesús de Nazaret*, 16 p.)




### HELP KEEP OUR KIDS SAFE! SAFETY TEAM MEMBERS NEEDED!






