The community of Saint Charles Borromeo is very anxious for July 1st to welcome Father Thomas Sunoj as our new parish priest and shepherd. A native of Kerala, India, he is the oldest of three sons born to his parents.

After graduating high school, he joined the Benedictine monastery and lived there for twelve years while completing college: five years of Latin, religious studies, a bachelor's degree in philosophy and master's degree in theology. Ordained in 2002, his superiors saw such great promise in him that they appointed him to start a new Benedictine community in the area where he oversaw the construction of monastic buildings and establishment of an agricultural farm.

His entrepreneurial skills were so good that his farm won numerous awards for spices grown there. As superior of his community, he was highly revered. In 2005, on a trip to the United States, he engaged in dialogue with various other monastic traditions which eventually led to a ministry of priestly service at the Benedictine Abbey in Conception and the northern region of Kansas City-Saint Joseph. He fell in love with his work in our diocese and, while his community sent him to Rome for advanced studies, he returned here often, living and serving at the Co-Cathedral in Saint Joseph, Saint Therese in Parkville, and Saint Thomas More in south Kansas City.

While studying sacred scripture in Rome, he worked at the Vatican and, intermittently, also took up studies in Germany. He is proficient in numerous languages, including Greek and Hebrew, that allowed him to study

the Bible in its original script. He also speaks Italian, Spanish, Malayalam, Hindi, Tamil, and English, as well as having working knowledge of Latin and German. He received a licentiate degree from the Pontifical Biblical Institute in Rome and from the Hebrew University in Jerusalem. He has guided pilgrimages to the Holy Land and is a popular instructor. Over the past decade he has returned periodically to teach at seminaries in India as well as at Conception Abbey. He was also assigned to give oversight to monasteries in Europe and in Africa. As you can surmise, he has incredible worldly knowledge and insight.

He joined the staff of at Saint Thomas More Parish in 2011, where we served together for five years before he was asked to pastor Saint Catherine of Siena Parish in south Kansas City, which he has done for the past six years. With the blessing of his Benedictine community, he became a citizen of the United States and is now a stable entity in our diocese where he knows, and is loved by, so many people. We are very blessed to have him become a part of the good things at Saint Charles, where he will help bring us to greater levels of knowledge, wisdom, faith, and holiness.

He is high-energy and brings a positive spirit to his ministerial works. He is well acquainted with Catholic school education and will be a tremendous blessing to Borromeo Academy. He connects well with young people and has helped out at various local high schools and youth programs. We have accomplished some wonderful feats here over the past six years and Father Thomas is one who can keep our faith community moving in a great direction.

As you welcome him and I move to another role in our city, let us pray for each other, that the Good Lord will continue to guide us.

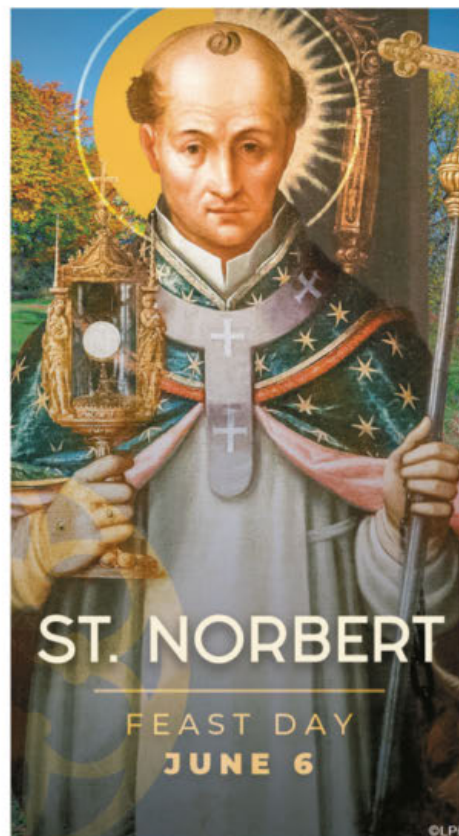

SAINT OF THE WEEK

Born to nobility, St. Norbert of Xanten, was ordained as a subdeacon and served in the court of Henry V, Emperor of Germany, however, at court it was easy to be distracted by wealth, power and luxury and he lived a worldly and corrupt life there. By the grace of God while traveling in a storm he was nearly struck by lightning and almost killed. This experience changed St. Norbert and he became penitent, left his court post, and after a period of discernment in a monastery, felt called to be a priest.

Norbert became an itinerant preacher, preaching against worldly attitudes but at the Pope's request finally settled in northern France and founded the Norbertine order established according to the rule of St. Augustine. The order grew rapidly and soon founded women's branch. Norbert traveled and preached across Germany where he also founded a lay branch of the Norbertines. In Belgium he preached against heresies which denied the Blessed Sacrament.

Eventually he was made Archbishop of Magdeburg, Germany, and later he traveled to Rome in support of Pope Innocent II, against the antipope. Afterward he returned to Germany to court of Emperor Lothar as advisor, at end of life, in failing health, St. Norbert was carried back to Magdeburg where he died.

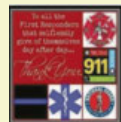

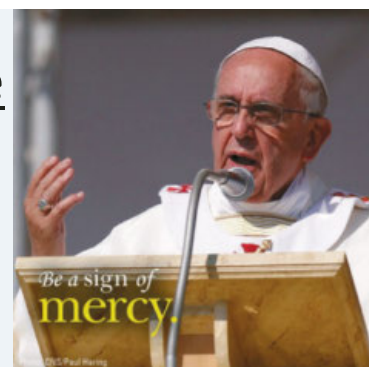

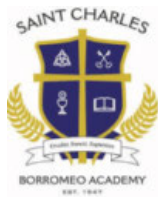
Diocese Golden Wedding Anniversary Masses

Baptismal Preparation

Infant - 6 Years: Parents of children under 6 years of age, or expectant parents who are registered parishioners and actively participating in the practice of Catholic faith and desire to have their child baptized need to attend one Baptism Preparation Class. Classes are offered every other month. **7 - 17 Years:** Participate in a special process, the Rite of Christian Initiation Adapted for Children. **Adults:** Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA), a faith journey that includes the teaching of the Catholic Church while focusing on each individual's formation in a life of discipleship and commitment to Jesus Christ.
