This Sunday we are celebrating our “Back to School” Mass with our school families at 11:00 a.m. I am really excited to welcome all our students, families and faculty to this new academic year. We have 39 new students joining our school from 26 families this year. Please join me in welcoming our new principal, Candace Stracener. I’d also like to welcome two new teachers: Sarah Niblock will be teaching middle school history and religion, and 3rd Grade will be taught by Lydia Gibson. Thank you all for your awesome support with your prayers, commitment and sharing your hard-earned money for the education of our awesome children. It is really fascinating to learn more, understand and get excited about classical education and, through this system as a faith community, how we are helping a beautiful generation to grow in stature and wisdom in favor with God and His people.

As we all know, classical education teaches students how to think and how to learn. In order to make classical education effective, we focus on how and when students are taught.

Regardless of their learning style, children learn in two phases or stages. In the grammar stage (K–5), students are naturally adept at memorizing through songs, chants, and rhymes. If you can get children in this stage to sing or chant something, they will remember it for a lifetime. In the dialectic or logic stage (grades 6–8), teenaged students are naturally more argumentative and begin to question authority and facts. They want to know the “why” of something—the logic behind it. During this stage, students learn reasoning, informal and formal logic, and how to argue with wisdom and eloquence. Therefore, at St. Charles Borromeo Academy, we focus on Formation for our children, not just information.

There are lots of opportunities to share your God-gifted time, talent and treasure and become Christ like in our community. This weekend we will get to know more about all the ministries here in our parish. I want to thank all the ministry leaders and participants for their awesome support, prayers and commitment to our Lord and making Jesus’ presence very visible in our parish. 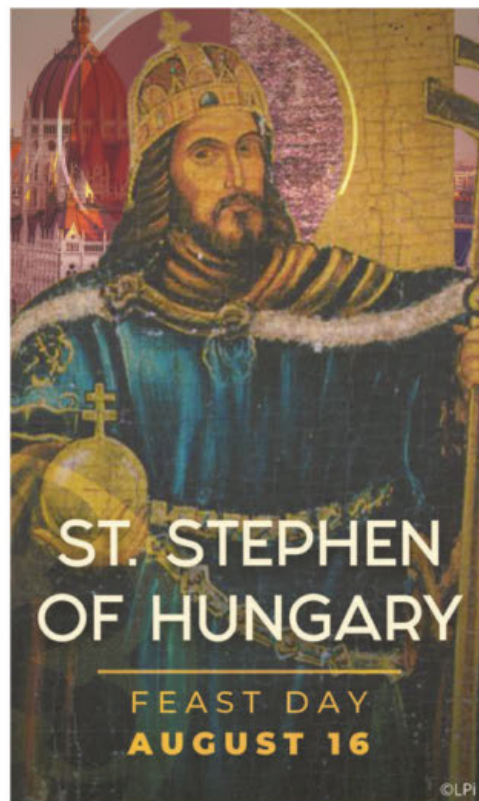

LIVE THE LITURGY Inspiration for the week

There is a "great cloud of witnesses" found in the official saints of the church and in ordinary people we meet every day. They are faith-filled inspirations who, by their example, help us to persevere in our faith. Living in a sea of conflict, change, challenge, and confusion, it is easy to grow tired and get weary. With so many things in competition for our attention, it is challenging to keep our eyes fixed on Jesus and the Kingdom of God. We have to keep running the race and continue proclaiming the Good News. This message is not always welcome. It can cause division, challenge accepted mindsets, ruffle peoples' feathers, and cause some folks to become defensive. God's ways are not always our ways. Even though often rejected by the world, the message of God in Jesus Christ must continue to be preached. We can rely on the examples of faith before us and around us and not lose heart. As Jesus endured the voices of opposition, so too can we.



SAINT OF THE WEEK

Born a pagan in the 10th century Saint Stephen was baptized as a boy when his father converted to Christianity. Saint Stephen married Gisela, daughter of Duke Henry II of Bavaria who would become Saint Henry II. He succeeded his father as leader and began to transform the nation into a Christian kingdom.

Pope Sylvester II proclaimed him the first king of Hungary in 1001, sending him a crown and gold processional cross. The crown, made in the Byzantine style, has become a symbol of Hungarian nationhood.

King Stephen's reign was a relatively peaceful and prosperous time. He outlawed paganism, mandated church building, and tithing for support of the parish, and commanded all to marry except clergy and religious. He founded a Benedictine monastery, and Hungary became an important place along the route to the Holy Land for many pilgrims.

Unfortunately, Stephen's son and heir died in a hunting accident, causing much conflict over the succession when the saint died. Eventually the kingdom was won back for Christendom and father and son were canonized in 1083 by Pope St. Gregory VII. Saint Stephen I is now patron saint of Hungary.

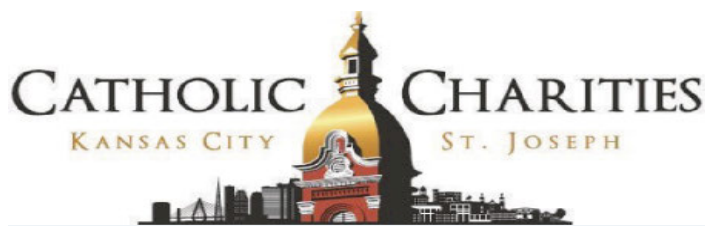

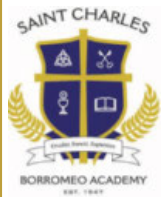
