Dear Northeast KCK Catholics,

This past week, the United States Supreme Court issued several important decisions, but one that did not receive much coverage will have major consequences for our church and society. Referred to as *Bostock*, this decision adds to the list of protected classes a person's sexual orientation or transgender status.

Archbishop Jose Gomes of Los Angeles, president of the conference of U.S. Bishops, issued the following statement:

"I am deeply concerned that the U.S. Supreme Court has effectively redefined the legal meaning of 'sex' in our nation's civil rights law. This is an injustice that will have implications in many areas of life.

"By erasing the beautiful differences and complementary relationship between man and woman, we ignore the glory of God's creation and harm the human family, the first building block of society. Our sex, whether we are male or female, is part of God's plan for creation and for our lives. As Pope Francis has taught with such sensitivity, to live in the truth with God's intended gifts in our lives requires that we receive our bodily and sexual identity with gratitude from our Creator. No one can find true happiness by pursuing a path that is contrary to God's plan.

"Every human person is made in the image and likeness of God and, without exception, must be treated with dignity, compassion, and respect. Protecting our neighbors from unjust discrimination does not require redefining human nature.

"We pray that the Church, with the help of Mary, the Mother of God, will be able to continue her mission to bring Jesus Christ to every man and woman."

Queridos Católicos del Noereste de KCK,

La semana pasada, la Corte Suprema de los Estados Unidos emitió varias decisiones importantes, pero una que no recibió mucha cobertura tendrá consecuencias importantes para nuestra iglesia y sociedad. Conocida como *Bostock*, esta decisión se suma a la lista de clases protegidas de la orientación sexual o el estado transgénero de una persona.

El arzobispo José Gomes de Los Ángeles, presidente de la conferencia de obispos de EE. UU., emitió la siguiente declaración:

"Me preocupa profundamente que la Corte Suprema de los Estados Unidos haya redefinido efectivamente el significado legal de "sexo" en la ley de derechos civiles de nuestra nación. Esta es una injusticia que tendrá implicaciones en muchas áreas de la vida.

"Al borrar las hermosas diferencias y la relación complementaria entre el hombre y la mujer, ignoramos la gloria de la creación de Dios y dañamos a la familia humana, el primer bloque de construcción de la sociedad. Nuestro sexo, ya sea hombre o mujer, es parte del plan de Dios para la creación y para nuestras vidas. Como el Papa Francisco ha enseñado con tanta sensibilidad, vivir en la verdad con los dones previstos de Dios en nuestras vidas requiere que recibamos nuestra identidad corporal y sexual con gratitud de nuestro Creador. Nadie puede encontrar la verdadera felicidad siguiendo un camino que es contrario al plan de Dios.

"Toda persona humana está hecha a imagen y semejanza de Dios y, sin excepción, debe ser tratada con dignidad, compasión y respeto. Proteger a nuestros vecinos de la discriminación injusta no requiere redefinir la naturaleza humana.

"Oramos para que la Iglesia, con la ayuda de María, la Madre de Dios, pueda continuar su misión de llevar a Jesucristo a cada hombre y mujer."
