Dear Northeast KCK Catholics,

The Mass for the 15th Sunday in Ordinary time opens with the chanting of the psalm, "*As for me, in justice I shall behold your face; I shall be filled with the vision of your glory.*" This prayer marks the beginning of a new chapter in the liturgical life of our parishes. At Christ the King and Blessed Sacrament, we will begin to incorporate what are known as the "propers" of the Mass into our sung prayer.

These texts, set to simple, often unaccompanied chanting by just a few voices, or a single one, are one part of our tradition that the Second Vatican Council revived so as to renew our experience of the Mass. The propers are meant to help the faithful to enter into the particular mystery of a given celebration. Unfortunately, many of these chants were displaced by more familiar hymns that excluded all other forms. In the present pandemic, while congregational singing is suspended, it seems opportune to once again restore these sung prayers to the Church's public worship.

I encourage you to listen intently and pray along in your minds and hearts with these chants.

Though you are not speaking them with your lips, it is possible to pray along with them in your heart, and allow them to carry you forward into the sacred mystery of the eternal self-offering of Jesus on the Cross.

The words are chosen very carefully from Scripture to reflect some aspect of the mystery we are about to celebrate. We are to hear and heed God's word. While this may seem unfamiliar at first, and terribly disengaging, give it time—soon, you will find them to be a rich source of meditation that will reward the prayerful attention you give them.

Queridos católicos del noreste de KCK,

La misa del 15º domingo del tiempo ordinario comienza con el canto del salmo: "**En cuanto a mí, en justicia veré tu rostro; Estaré lleno de la visión de tu Gloria**". Esta oración marca el comienzo de un nuevo capítulo en la vida litúrgica de nuestras parroquias. En Cristo Rey y Santísimo Sacramento, comenzaremos a incorporar lo que se conoce como los "proprios" de la Misa en nuestra oración cantada.

Estos textos, establecidos en cantos simples, a menudo no acompañados por solo unas pocas veces, o una sola, son una parte de nuestra tradición que revivió el Concilio Vaticano II para renovar nuestra experiencia de la Misa. Los propios deben ayudar a fieles para entrar en el misterio particular de una celebración dada. Desafortunadamente, muchos de estos cantos fueron desplazados por himnos más familiares que excluyeron todas las demás formas. En la pandemia actual, mientras se suspende el canto congregacional, parece oportuno una vez más restaurar estas oraciones cantadas al culto público de la Iglesia.

Te animo a escuchar atentamente y rezar en tus mentes y corazones con estos cantos. Aunque no los estás hablando con tus labios, es posible orar junto con ellos en tu corazón y permitir que te lleven al misterio sagrado de la eterna ofrenda de Jesús en la Cruz.

Las palabras se eligen con mucho cuidado de la Escritura para reflejar algún aspecto del misterio que estamos a punto de celebrar. Debemos escuchar y escuchar la palabra de Dios. Si bien esto puede parecer poco familiar al principio, y terriblemente desacoplarse, denle tiempo; pronto, encontrará que son una rica fuente de meditación que recompensará la atención orante que les brinda.

WELCOME DOUG O'NEILL

DIRECTOR OF FORMATION IN SACRED MUSIC

I am delighted to begin my service to God and the Church in Kansas City as your new Director of Formation in Sacred Music and Liturgy at Christ the King School and Church, and at Blessed Sacrament. I recently moved here with my wife Sujin Yoon and 10-year old son Evan, but I am no stranger to the area. From 1997-2001 I lived in Lawrence and worked in Kansas City, while studying for the DMA in Church Music. Sujin and I met at the University of Kansas, and were married in Kansas City in 2006. After completing degrees in organ performance, I became more interested in choral conducting and in the philosophy of church music. I spent six years as Assistant Director of Music at the Cathedral of the Madeleine and Madeleine Choir School in Salt Lake City. The Madeleine Choir School is the only full-time co-educational Catholic choir school in North America. With that unique experience, I understand the crucial need to expose children to a life immersed in beauty.

Over the coming months and years, we will be introducing the students at Christ the King School to the great Roman Catholic tradition of chant and polyphony. This is a living tradition—not museum pieces frozen in time, but music to be cherished and appreciated today. It should be noted as well that the tradition allows for new artistic expressions of quality that respect that heritage.

I am excited that Christ the King School is transitioning to a classical model, in which music is regarded not as a side project, but as essential. We will be teaching the children to not just make music, but also to understand it. On a daily basis, they will be exposed to great music and to great sacred texts that will enrich their lives and edify all who listen to it, and that will give glory to God through the liturgy. This will be a long journey that we are just beginning, and I pray for God's help and yours along the way.

DIRECTOR DE FORMACION EN MUSICA SAGRADA

Estoy encantado de comenzar mi servicio a Dios y a la Iglesia en Kansas City como el nuevo Director de Formación en Música Sagrada y Liturgia en la Escuela e Iglesia Christ the King, y en Blessed Sacrament. Recientemente me mudé aquí con mi esposa Sujin Yoon y mi hijo Evan de 10 años, pero no soy ajeno a la zona. Después de completar los títulos en interpretación de órgano, me interesé más en la dirección coral y en la filosofía de la música de iglesia. Madeleine Choir School es la única escuela de coro católico coeducativo a tiempo completo en América del Norte. Con esa experiencia única, entiendo la necesidad crucial de exponer a los niños a una vida inmersa en la belleza.

En los próximos meses y años, presentaremos a los estudiantes de la escuela Christ the King la gran tradición católica romana de canto y polifonía. Esta es una tradición viva: no piezas de museo congeladas en el tiempo, sino música para apreciar y apreciar hoy. Cabe señalar también que la tradición permite nuevas expresiones artísticas de calidad que respetan ese patrimonio.

Estoy emocionado de que la escuela Christ the King esté haciendo la transición a un modelo clásico, en el que la música no se considera un proyecto paralelo, sino esencial.
