Dear Northeast KCK Catholics,
In the coming weeks, please keep an eye on the bulletin as Dr. O'Neill will be using this space to begin a series of explanations about liturgical music and practice.

As students return to school this week, we ask that you keep this new academic year in your prayers—that all of us, students, teachers, administrators, and families alike will grow in wisdom and virtue. **Would you please consider offering a rosary as a family for this intention?**

With students beginning their music instruction, we want them to be confident leaders in helping to sing *the* Mass rather than to sing *at* Mass. With the approval of the Archdiocese, we will begin to use more and more of the sung responses in Mass, as called for by the liturgical teaching of the Church.

Those who attend daily Mass at Christ the King will be seeing our schoolchildren at Mass more during the week. Upper level students will attend Mass each **Tuesday and Friday**; the younger students will attend each **Wednesday**. That practice will begin the week of September 14th.

As schedules begin to change, consider committing to an hour of adoration before the Eucharist each week. Adoration hours are from 9am-6pm each Wednesday at CTK, and from 9am-8pm each Thursday at Blessed Sacrament. **Those who are still reluctant to return to Mass to make this part of their week!**

ST. PETER CLAVER

St. Peter Claver was born at Verdu, Catalonia, Spain, in 1580, studied at the Jesuit college of Barcelona, entered the Jesuit novitiate at Tarragona in 1602 and took his final vows on August 8th, 1604. While studying philosophy at Majorca, the young religious was influenced by St. Alphonsus Rodriguez to go to the Indies and save "millions of perishing souls."

In 1610, he landed at Cartagena (modern Colombia), the principle slave market of the New World, where a thousand slaves were landed every month. After his ordination in 1616, he dedicated himself by special vow to the service of the Negro slaves-a work that was to last for thirty-three years.

Boarding the slave ships at harbor, he would hurry to the hold, and offer whatever refreshments he could afford; care for the sick and dying, and instruct the slaves through Negro catechists before administering the Sacraments. Through his efforts three hundred thousand souls entered the Church. He died in 1654

SAN PEDRO CLAVER

San Pedro Claver nació en Verdú, Cataluña, España, en 1580, estudió en el colegio Jesuita de Barcelona, entró en el noviciado Jesuita de Tarragona en 1602 y emitió sus votos finales el 8 de agosto de 1604. Mientras estudiaba filosofía en Mallorca, el joven religioso fue influenciado por San Alfonso Rodríguez para ir a las Indias y salvar "millones de almas moribundas".

En 1610, desembarcó en Cartagena (la actual Colombia), el principal mercado de esclavos del Nuevo Mundo, donde desembarcaban mil esclavos cada mes. Después de su ordenación en 1616, se dedicó por voto especial al servicio de los esclavos negros, un trabajo que duraría treinta y tres años.

Abordando los barcos de esclavos en el puerto, se apresuraba a la bodega y ofrecía cualquier refrigerio que pudiera permitirse; cuidar a los enfermos y moribundos, e instruir a los esclavos a través de catequistas negros antes de administrar los sacramentos. Gracias a sus esfuerzos, trescientas mil almas entraron en la Iglesia. Murió en 1654

A MESSAGE FROM DR. O'NEILL

Good news - we can sing again at Mass! That is, we can sing certain things, in a limited fashion, which is certainly a step above no congregational singing whatsoever. This is based on recent studies that have shown light singing through masks to pose no more risk of spreading the virus than speaking at the same volume level. We will be undertaking an initiative to sing more of the Mass, starting with the dialogues and acclamations. Given that they are short and do not need to be sung in a vigorous manner that would expel droplets, they are a good place to start. In fact, the Roman Catholic Church tells us that these are actually the most important elements of the Mass to be sung, and for that reason, they must be sung by all present, never by the cantor or choir alone. Dialogues are parts like the opening greeting of Mass: "The Lord be with you." "And with your spirit." There are several acclamations during Mass as well; perhaps the most memorable one is the Memorial Acclamation during the Eucharistic Prayer. In an effort to directly tie music class at the school with service in the Mass, the students at Christ the King Classical School will gradually be learning these sung Mass elements, and applying them at weekend and "school" Masses during the week. Especially if you are not yet comfortable with these responses, please encourage the children to take the lead. It is an opportunity for them to show some leadership and sense of responsibility in service to the Church. This will be a great way to build up our singing communities in the parishes, and to lift up our voices to God in a manner that is responsible, given the current situation. Thanks be to God!



UN MENSAJE DEL DR. O 'NEILL

Buenas noticias: ¡podemos cantar de nuevo en la misa! Es decir, podemos cantar ciertas cosas, de manera limitada, lo que ciertamente es un paso por encima del canto congregacional en absoluto. Esto se basa en estudios recientes que han demostrado que el canto ligero a través de máscaras no presenta más riesgo de propagar el virus de que hablar al mismo nivel de volumen. Empezaremos una iniciativa para cantar más la Misa, comenzando con los diálogos y acclamaciones. Dado que son cortos y no es necesario cantarlos de manera vigorosa que expulsarían gotitas de saliva, son un buen punto de partida. De hecho, la Iglesia Católica Romana nos dice que estos son en realidad los elementos más importantes de la Misa para ser cantados, y por esa razón, deben ser cantados por todos los presentes, nunca por el cantor o el coro solo. Los diálogos son partes como el saludo inicial de la Misa: "El Señor esté ustedes". "Y con tu espíritu." También hay varias acclamaciones durante la misa; quizás el más memorable es la Acclamación Conmemorativa durante la Plegaria Eucarística. En un esfuerzo por vincular directamente la clase de música en la escuela con el servicio en la Misa, los estudiantes de Christ the King Classical School aprenderán gradualmente estos elementos de la Misa cantada y los aplicarán en las Misas de fin de semana y "escolares" durante la semana. Especialmente si aún no se siente cómodo con estas respuestas, anime a los niños a tomar la iniciativa. Es una oportunidad para que demuestren cierto liderazgo y sentido de responsabilidad al servicio de la Iglesia. Esta será una excelente manera de construir nuestras comunidades de canto en las parroquias y de levantar nuestra voz a Dios de una manera responsable, dada la situación actual. ¡Gracias a Dios!


