Dear Catholics of Northeast KCK,

This coming week, I'll be away for a personal retreat and reading group with a number of good priest friends from across the country. In this short time between the Christmas season and Lent, I wanted to take some time to process, pray, and reflect on what has been a tough year for our Church and country.

I'll be honest—I don't like much of what I'm seeing. It feels as if the fabric of our civic culture is rapidly unraveling. My heart is heavy with the divisions that only seem to be intensifying, at the expense of solidarity, virtue, and goodwill. What awaits us in 2021? We are more ready to believe the worst of one another than ever before. To some extent, we're all troubled by these conflicts. It's starting to feel normal to see what was once unthinkable on the evening news. Of course, it can *always* get worse. What will heal our fractured bonds?

I hesitate to speak on these issues, because in a shouting match, it's best not to add to the din. What I'm sure of is that we must turn toward Christ again and again in order to not be dominated by contrary spirits.

In this new year of grace, I find myself very conscious of the many influences that give me reason to judge others uncharitably. Now, don't get me wrong: making judgments is important. We need to make them as we attempt to understand ourselves and others. But uncharitable judgments come easily to us—far more easily than charitable ones. We conclude all sorts of things from second-hand information or uncertain facts, and attribute motives to others without caution. One of my resolutions for this year is to cultivate the habit of trying to judge people and events that frustrate me with the most prayerful and charitable interpretation possible. Will you join me?

Mi corazón está pesado por las divisiones que solo parecen intensificarse, a expensas de la solidaridad, la virtud y la buena voluntad. ¿Qué nos espera en 2021? Estamos más dispuestos que nunca a creer lo peor de los demás. Hasta cierto punto, todos estamos preocupados por estos conflictos. Empieza a parecer normal ver lo que antes era impensable en las noticias de la tarde. Por supuesto, *siempre* puede empeorar. ¿Qué curará nuestros lazos fracturados? Dudo en hablar sobre estos temas, porque en una pelea a gritos, es mejor no aumentar el ruido. De lo que estoy seguro es que debemos volvernos hacia Cristo una y otra vez para no dejarnos dominar por espíritus contrarios. En este nuevo año de gracia, me encuentro muy consciente de las muchas influencias que me dan motivos para juzgar a los demás sin caridad. Ahora, no me malinterpreten: hacer juicios es importante. Necesitamos hacerlos mientras intentamos comprendernos a nosotros mismos y a los demás. Pero los juicios no caritativos nos llegan fácilmente, mucho más fácilmente que los caritativos. Concluimos todo tipo de cosas a partir de información de segunda mano o hechos inciertos, y atribuimos motivos a otros sin precaución. Una de mis resoluciones para este año es cultivar el hábito de tratar de juzgar a las personas y los eventos que me frustran con la interpretación más piadosa y caritativa posible. ¿Me acompañaras?

We are excited to announce the formation of the **Christus Rex Schola Cantorum**, an after-school children's choir program for Grades 4-8. To comply with safe distancing protocols for singing in choirs during the pandemic, we will form two choirs. Beginning in January, Choir A will sing for the 9:30a.m. English Mass on Sunday at Christ the King Church; and Choir B will sing for the newly created Sunday 6:00 p.m. Spanish Mass at Blessed Sacrament Church. The children will be expected to commit to three of four Sundays per month, with one Sunday off.

VALUE THEM BOTH

The new Kansas Legislature is likely to vote soon on the Value Them Both Kansas Constitution Amendment. We will begin to pray for the successful passage of Value Them Both with a petition during the Prayers of the Faithful. What is VALUE THEM BOTH? VTB is the proposed state constitutional amendment for life supported by the Catholic Bishops of Kansas. On April 26, 2019, the Kansas Supreme Court created a nearly unlimited “right” to abortion in the 1859 Kansas Constitution which continues to allow the live dismemberment of preborn children in our state. Due to this ruling, all of our existing prolife laws including bans on taxpayer-funded and late-term abortions will be considered unconstitutional once challenged. The VALUE THEM BOTH amendment will reverse the Supreme Court ruling and once again allow Kansans, through their elected representatives, to pass laws that will help protect women and their unborn babies from the abortion industry. Please pray for passage of VALUE THEM BOTH.
