“Mary becomes a model for the Church’s mission, that is, that of being a dwelling place for the Word, preserving it and keeping it safe in times of confusion, protecting it, as it were, from the elements. Hence, she is also the interpretation of the parable of the seed sown in good soil and yielding fruit a hundredfold. She is not the thin surface that cannot accommodate roots; she is not the barren earth that the sparrows have pecked bare; nor is she overgrown by the weeds of affluence that inhibit new growth. She is a human being with depth....

“In our activity-orientated, one-sidedly masculine, Western Christianity, contemplation is more and more undervalued. The loss of contemplation, moreover, is largely identical with the loss of the Marian aspect. We have been trying to justify Christianity primarily on the basis of deeds. But where ‘being’ is trampled underfoot, our deeds soon become monstrous...

“Thus the increasing loss of the Marian element in the Church only serves to underline once again how necessary it is. The Church must be a realm of quiet, a place of meditation and silence. She lives by the heart’s memory, which penetrates to the core of things and so opens them to understanding. This is the only way in which man can enjoy real progress... And it is precisely through Marian contemplation, which is not always trying to produce things and yield measurable results, that the Church ministers to man. For by doing so she causes the Word of God to penetrate the world, that meaning without which all our possessions are nothing but dead weight.”

“María se convierte en modelo de la misión de la Iglesia, es decir, de ser morada de la Palabra, preservarla y mantenerla a salvo en tiempos de confusión, protegiéndola, por así decirlo, de los elementos. Por lo tanto, ella es también la interpretación de la parábola de la semilla sembrada en buena tierra y que da fruto al cien por cien. Ella no es la superficie delgada que no puede acomodar raíces; no es la tierra yerma que los gorriones picotearon al descubierto; tampoco está cubierta por las malas hierbas de la opulencia que inhiben el nuevo crecimiento. Ella es un ser humano con profundidad....

“En nuestro Cristianismo Occidental orientado a la actividad, unilateralmente masculino, la contemplación es cada vez más infravalorada. La pérdida de la contemplación, además, es en gran parte idéntica a la pérdida del aspecto Mariano. Hemos tratado de justificar el Cristianismo principalmente sobre la base de los hechos. Pero donde el “ser” es pisoteado, nuestras acciones pronto se vuelven monstruosas ...

“Así, la creciente pérdida del elemento mariano en la Iglesia sólo sirve para subrayar una vez más lo necesario que es. La Iglesia debe ser un reino de tranquilidad, un lugar de meditación y silencio. Vive de la memoria del corazón, que penetra hasta el fondo de las cosas y las abre al entendimiento. Esta es la única forma en que el hombre puede disfrutar de un verdadero progreso ... Y es precisamente a través de la contemplación mariana, que no siempre trata de producir cosas y resultados mensurables, que la Iglesia ministra al hombre. Porque al hacerlo, hace que la Palabra de Dios penetre en el mundo, ese significado sin el cual todas nuestras posesiones no son más que un peso muerto”.

SUNDAY MASS OBLIGATION RETURNS

Archbishop Naumann has chosen the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, **the weekend of June 5-6, 2021**, as the occasion on which the dispensation from the obligation by the faithful to attend Mass shall be lifted. Beginning with Masses for that weekend, all the Catholic faithful residing within the Archdiocese of Kansas City in Kansas must return to observing the precept of the Church to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation. As always, those who suffer from underlying health concerns or compromised immunity are not bound by the obligation to attend Mass.

Catholics, of course, should always hunger for the Eucharist and long to receive the Body and Blood of Christ in Holy Communion, but especially now, as we begin to depart from restrictions imposed by the pandemic. As the Church solemnly teaches, the Eucharist is the summit of the Church's mission, and is the font from which all her power to serve God is derived. Archbishop Naumann will be writing about our true need for Holy Mass in his column in *The Leaven*, inviting the faithful to communal celebration of the Eucharist in their parishes.

Whether one is obligated to attend Mass or not, **we are nonetheless obliged to keep holy the Lord's Day**. The faithful who are unable to attend Mass should celebrate a liturgy of the Word in their home, using the Sunday readings; like all the faithful, they should refrain from unnecessary work and avoid unnecessary shopping, and should spend time in leisure, rest, and prayer with their families and loved ones.

FIN DE LA DISPENSA

Monseñor Naumann ha elegido la solemnidad del Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo, **el fin de semana del 5 y 6 de junio de 2021**, como ocasión en la que se levantará la dispensa de la obligación de los fieles de asistir a la misa. Comenzando con las misas de ese fin de semana, todos los fieles católicos que residen dentro de la Arquidiócesis de Kansas City en Kansas deben volver a observar el precepto de la Iglesia para asistir a misa los domingos y las fiestas de obligación. Como siempre, aquellos que sufren de problemas de salud subyacentes o inmunidad comprometida no están bajo la obligación de asistir a misa.

Los católicos, por supuesto, siempre deben tener hambre de la Eucaristía y anhelar recibir el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo en la Santa Comunión, pero especialmente ahora, a medida que comenzamos a apartarnos de las restricciones impuestas por la pandemia. Como la Iglesia enseña solemnemente, la Eucaristía es la cumbre de la misión de la Iglesia, y es la fuente de la que se deriva todo su poder para servir a Dios. Monseñor Naumann escribirá sobre nuestra verdadera necesidad de la santa misa, invitando a los fieles a la celebración comunitaria de la Eucaristía en sus parroquias.

Independientemente de si uno está obligado a asistir a misa o no, no obstante, **estamos obligados a santificar el día del Señor**. Los fieles que no pueden asistir a la misa deben celebrar una liturgia de la Palabra en su hogar, utilizando las lecturas dominicales; como todos los fieles, deben abstenerse del trabajo innecesario y evitar compras innecesarias, y deben pasar tiempo de descanso y de oración con sus familias y queridos.
