How's the planning going as we look to merge with St Joseph in Pierce this summer?

Good! We are beginning the process of moving forward as our parish councils meet next week with Fr Jeff Lorig. Fr Lorig, head of pastoral planning, will present the overview that was given to all the priests in Fremont a month ago laying out the rationale for why we are moving in this direction as the number of priests retiring will lag far behind the number of ordinations. A great source for information is found at: <https://equip.archomaha.org/category/pastoral-planning/>. Here Fr Lorig and his staff outline the rationale, have some great thoughts on the process and seek to keep communication open.

Among the suggestions Fr Lorig office desires us to embrace are:

1) A shared parish council: with fewer priests and more responsibility a shared pastoral council will enable the pastor to plan and execute with a team from all the parishes he is assigned to. While each parish is required by church law to have a finance council other parish teams would work together.

These teams The Archdiocese is suggesting could include:

- 2) Religious education of adults and children
- 3) business and financial management
- 4) Parish missions and outreach
- 5) Liturgical planning and others

Please pray this meeting goes well and we move forward along with all the parishes in the rural areas to a future of hope!



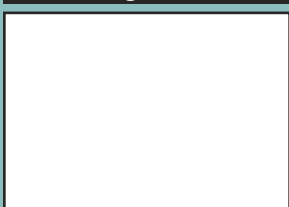
