

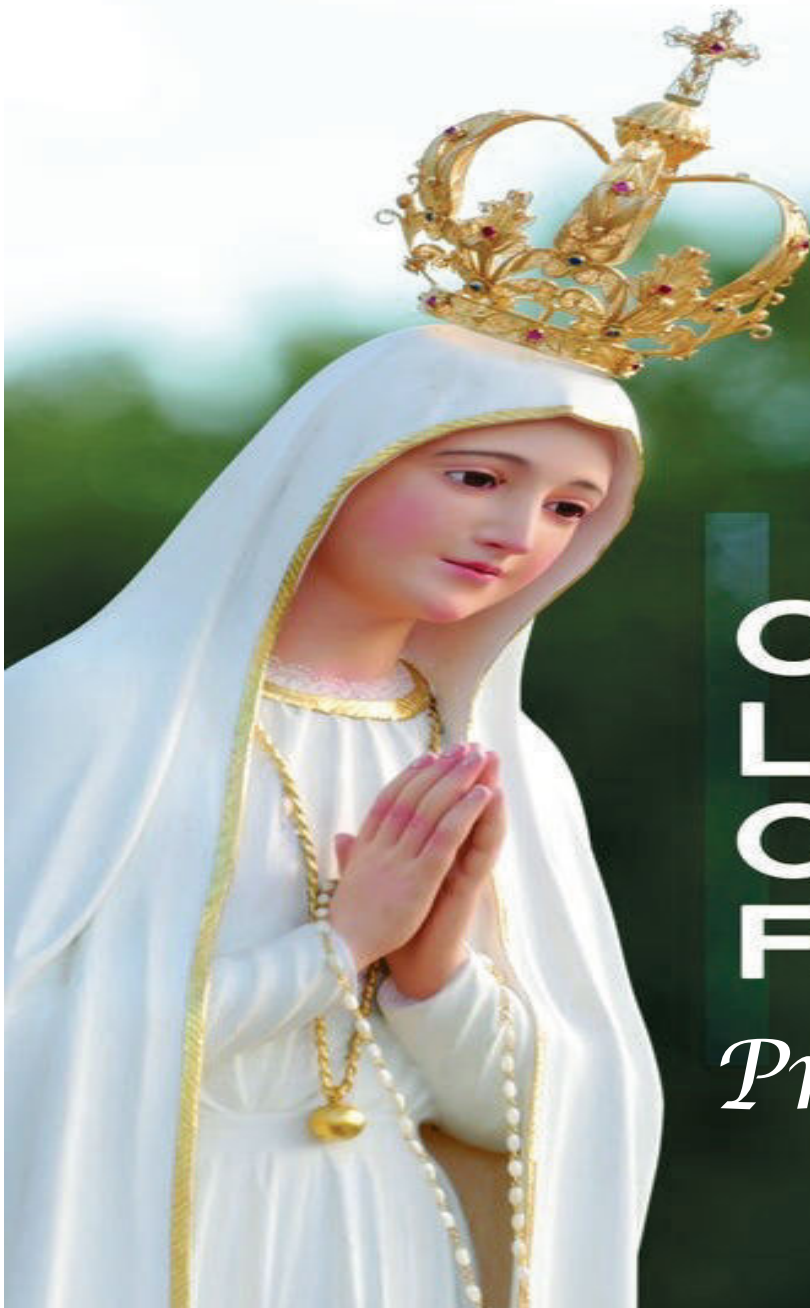

### THE LITURGY OF THE WORD

#### FIRST READING

Acts 6:1-7

As the number of disciples continued to grow, the Hellenists complained against the Hebrews because their widows were being neglected in the daily distribution.

So the Twelve called together the community of the disciples and said, "It is not right for us to neglect the word of God to serve at table. Brothers, select from among you seven reputable men, filled with the Spirit and wisdom, whom we shall appoint to this task, whereas we shall devote ourselves to prayer and to the ministry of the word."

The proposal was acceptable to the whole community, so they chose Stephen, a man filled with faith and the Holy Spirit, also Philip, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, and Nicholas of Antioch, a convert to Judaism. They presented these men to the apostles who prayed and laid hands on them.

The word of God continued to spread, and the number of the disciples in Jerusalem increased greatly; even a large group of priests were becoming obedient to the faith.

Beloved:

For it says in Scripture:

*Behold, I am laying a stone in Zion, a cornerstone, chosen and precious, and whoever believes in it shall not be put to shame.*

Therefore, its value is for you who have faith, but for those without faith:

*The stone that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone, and A stone that will make people stumble, and a rock that will make them fall.*

They stumble by disobeying the word, as is their destiny.

You are "a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people of his own, so that you may announce the praises" of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.

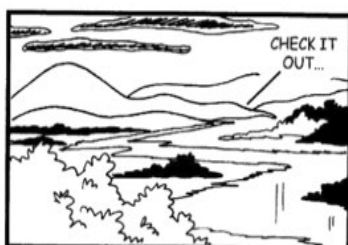

Of course, it is more than just a place for Catholics to pray; it is an iconic achievement of artistic mastery; and a cherished Sioux Falls landmark beloved by people from all walks of life from all over the region. It is here, that the beautiful and the sacred come together in an inspiring way.

Through the generosity of many, the Cathedral has been undergoing a comprehensive restoration to continue its prominence and ensure its legacy for generations to come, including most recently, the restoration of the Cathedral interior completed in 2011.

The next phase, called the “*In Spires Capital Campaign*,” will provide a world-class organ, a restored rectory of historical consequences, along with endowments that will expand programs for music and liturgy, and ensure the upkeep of the organ and rectory, all with the intention of giving God glory.

Because of the importance of these initiatives, I invite you to pray and familiarize yourself with the *In Spires Capital Campaign* and integrate these objectives into your charitable priorities over the next five years. God has put on my heart the importance of each of us making a gift in gratitude to Him for our many blessings, including our Cathedral faith community.

We hope through the generosity and benevolence of our parish community that we will realize our \$10 million goal for these projects and endowments. Thank you in advance for prayerfully considering to invest in the future of our Cathedral and the future of our priests.
