



Merry Christmas,

A Christmas letter is sometimes more beneficial to the author than to the reader, but I hope you will find this to be a fruitful read as well. For me, it is a chance to review the year, to note the challenges, the blessings, and to hope for more blessings in the future. I recall the letter I wrote to you a year ago. We were still navigating how to celebrate Christmas safely in our churches. While Covid numbers today are not all that different from last year, there certainly seems to be a change in the way we've decided to live with it, for better or worse, depending on your perspective. Vaccines, boosters, masks, and a better understanding of the virus have all given many a greater confidence in how to traverse these still uncertain times.

In 2018 I was blessed to celebrate Mass in Bethlehem, just a few feet from the actual Nativity of Jesus Christ. Powerful enough in itself, there was an added blessing of celebrating Mass with a Christian woman who grew up and lived in Bethlehem. When I preached the homily that day, I spoke from the place of what it might be like to be

her. It is not easy to be Christian in the Holy Land. One is constantly caught up in the chaos of hostility among different peoples, endless terrorism, and persistent persecution. It is a place of uncertainty and disharmony. It is a far cry from the sentimental words of "Silent Night." Not all is calm or bright. Yet, this is where God chose to be present among us, in our chaos and uncertainty. Christmas is where Hope is born. God is with us!

And so here we are today. All of us battle our own struggles, enduring them with Hope! Christmas reminds us to hope for what we could not have possibly dared to hope. Change and uncertainty have the potential to threaten our peace, but they are not the real enemies. They are constant, and we will never be rid of them. Rather, the real enemy is our choosing to despair in them, to live in fear rather than hope.

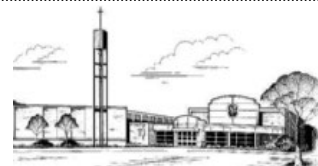

Do You Feel Called to be a Substitute Teach?

You can qualify for a substitute certificate if you:

- *have 60 semester hours of college coursework,
- *have completed one professional education course,
- *are willing or have completed one human relations training course,
- *are willing or have completed the Archdiocesan Safe Environment Training.

As part of the application process, anyone not living in Nebraska continuously for the past five years must submit fingerprint cards and a fingerprint processing fee at the time of application. All applicants must send official transcripts from their college or university directly to the teacher certification office of the Nebraska Department of Education. As the final step of the application, the Catholic School's Office will send a letter to the Department of Education approving you as a sub.
