

#### **PASTOR'S DESK**


Dear Friends in Christ.

### Stewardship






"Stewardship is about recognizing and receiving God's gifts and sharing them proportionately and sacrificially. It's about following Jesus Christ. It's about conversion."



Do you have a calling to help with our faith formation classes or youth group?

Right now the parish has a need for more Virtus qualified volunteers to help support our ministry team on a routine basis. Before regularly working or volunteering with minors or vulnerable adults, all diocesan personnel are required to first complete I) the Safe Environment Training; 2) have a Background Screening conducted; and, 3) submit the current and signed Code of Conduct. The Safe Environment training is now available online after creating an account in the VIRTUS system (through the VIRTUS webpage at: https:// www.virtusonline.org/virtus/).



We are looking forward to another year of our popular RCIA program (that is, Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults), which consists of college students and adults of all ages.

RCIA classes begin on Thursday September 14 from 6:30pm - 8:00Pm - plan on coming to the parish office area and we will direct you accordingly.




