Faithful People of Saint Thomas More,

Last weekend we had our first round of First Communion celebrations, with our PSR and homeschooling families. I want to thank Dana Epperly who has overseen their formation this year, as well as the parents of these First Communicants who often participated in our twice-monthly sessions. It was a joy to celebrate with all of you!

Our STM School community celebrates their First Communion celebrations this Sunday afternoon, and due to this event, our regular Sunday Adoration schedule has a late start: 4PM. We will still conclude Adoration at the usual 9PM.

For those of you signed-up (or contemplating signing up!) for our Fall Pilgrimage to England to visit the sites of our patron, Saint Thomas More, Father Davis has agreed to an additional trip to Scotland, as several pilgrims had asked about this possibility. There's no obligation, but folks can "upgrade" with an additional three nights in Scotland, ahead of our London itinerary. Details are on the STM webpage.

Lastly, I'd like to note a few ministries that you might be unfamiliar with at STM, but that remain in play for our community:

Living Waters, a 20-week ministry for those who are looking to deepen their ability to be a good gift in their relationships, by allowing the Lord to tend to areas of brokenness in their lives, wraps up their most recent offering this week. A dozen team leaders - which include a Catholic priest (me!) and a religious sister - accompanied 25 men and women of all backgrounds and ages as they sought to find healing and strength through the members of Christ's body: the Church. Look for the next offering of this transformational ministry in a few months.

Reach More, which has been offering small group opportunities for the last year and half, is having their participants serve coffee and doughnuts after the 7:30AM and 9AM Masses throughout the month of May. This ministry helps participants grow in the conviction of God's call for them to be ambassadors of his Good News, and recognize the ways in which God is equipping them for this amazing responsibility.

Both of these ministries testify to the invaluable gift of relationships and community. Because of the saving work of Jesus, these gifts are ours for the taking! Want to know more about these ministries? Ask me! Or allow me to connect you with members of my staff or fellow parishioners who are engaged with these community-minded experiences. Any of us would be glad to help get you positioned with ministries that can begin to unlock the expansion of life that God desires for His people.


