I'm Back!

It was right around a year ago I wrote my last bulletin article for the parish. As we entered into lockdown due to COVID, everything changed! We were getting one or more messages a week from the diocese with directives and instructions on how to handle the pandemic. As things changed, by necessity we altered what we did here at the parish. One of the many things I never thought would occur was the abrupt ending of printed bulletins. With no one here in-person, and still a question on how the virus spread, we were unsure if printed bulletins would ever become a thing again.

Thanks be to God, the lockdown was relatively short and it was not long after returning to in-person prayer that we resumed the bulletin. The problem was that I got out of the habit of writing my weekly article. I was grateful that several shared they read my message each week and were sad that it was missing. Having now made it through the Easter celebrations and feeling like we have post-COVID life in the parish down a little more, I think this is a good time to return to this practice!

I want to reiterate the words I shared on Holy Thursday when reflecting on the gift of the Most Holy Priesthood; I am here to serve you! The night of the Last Supper, Our Lord washed the feet of the disciples and made it clear that this was the position they were to have; the position of a servant to the people. The priest is not meant to lord it over the parish, he is meant to be Christ to the parish. Just as Christ came to serve, so I (and all priests) are sent to serve the parish. As such, I want to echo my words which were shared on my first weekend here as well as many times after; I am here for you! If there is anything I can do to help you on your faith journey, I am happy to do so! If you have a problem or concern about how the parish is being run, let's talk about it! If you are having a hard time with the message you are hearing from the Ambo each week, let's look at it and see how we can find peace for you. Although I am called to be Christ to you, I am not divine and I know I have made mistakes and will continue to make mistakes, but talking about them in the parking lot will not help the parish, you, or me. My E-Mail is listed weekly in the bulletin along with the parish phone number. Please don't hesitate to use them! We have been blessed with nearly three years walking this journey of salvation together, and I look forward to whatever time God has left for us to be together!
