

➤ From Father Barlett ➤

Catechism of the Catholic Church 54-64; The Stages of Revelation

(CCC 54) God has never kept Himself hidden from us. He has always revealed Himself to us, going all the way back to our first parents in the Garden of Eden, and He continues to reveal Himself to us to this day. He reveals Himself mainly through created reality, but also does so in a personal way so as to invite us into relationship.

(CCC 55) This revelation of God to us couldn't even be hampered with original sin. Instead, God used such a tragedy to reveal to us His wonderful plan for salvation. We are made for eternal life with God, and so He reveals that good news to us. God's plan for salvation came through the covenants, three of which we will look at today.

(CCC 56) After the great flood, God formed a covenant with Noah and promised His grace to humanity as they are grouped together by land, language, and nation.

(CCC 57) The disunity we experience when looking at the different nations is designed to keep us humble. Humanity tried to form its own unity in the great city of Babel, but God scrambled our language and dispersed us so that we would understand that true unity comes from God alone.

(CCC 58) In this covenant which remained in force until the universal proclamation of the Gospel, we find great spiritual leaders such as Abel the Just, Melchizedek, Noah, Danial, and Job. They are our examples, showing us that sanctity can be reached if one follows the covenant of God.

(CCC 59) In the next covenant with Abraham, God called scattered humanity together under our one 'father in faith.'

(CCC 60) To this gathering of nations, God gave His promise of salvation which prepared for the opening of the covenant to the Gentiles; the possibility of universal salvation.

(CCC 61) We are given many great saint, patriarchs, and prophets during the time of this covenant.

(CCC 62) After the nations were gathered in the one faith, God formed them into one single people through His covenant with Moses. The central act where this covenant was formed was the Passover and the freeing of God's people from Egypt. It is in this covenant that God also gave the law to His people so they would know how to live rightly.

(CCC 63) The people of Israel still hold a special place in salvation history being our "elder

brethren" in the faith of Abraham.

(CCC 64) This was the final stage, setting up humanity to be ready for the new and eternal Covenant intended for all people. In this covenant, we find redemption, purification of the soul, and the possibility of salvation open to everyone.

When it comes to understanding the faith, the more we can know and reflect on the covenants, the better we will see God's plan of salvation for all. This is the key to everything! Understand the covenants and you will understand why we have every aspect of our faith.
