

Catechism of the Catholic Church 74-79; The Transmission of Divine Revelation; The Apostolic Tradition

(CCC 74) Because God desires all to be saved and hear the truth (I Tim 2:4), He put in place a system which allows for the transmission of divine revelation to be passed down through the ages and to all generations.

(CCC 75) Christ charged His apostles with the task of preaching the Gospel which He gave to them from His own lips. In the Gospel we find the source of all truth which brings about salvation as well as directions for living a moral life.

(CCC 76) There are two ways the Gospel was handed on through history. First is through oral tradition. This began with Christ and continued through the Apostles. Oral tradition encompasses the passing on of divine revelation through both speech and through the manner of life of one who lived rightly. Preaching the Gospel is not done just through words, but through actions as well. The other mode of transmitting is through the written tradition. The written tradition came about through the apostles and their direct successors being inspired by the Holy Spirit to write down the good news for generations to come.

(CCC 77) To be sure the apostolic mission continued, the apostles left bishops to be their successors, entrusting in them this essential ministry and responsibility of passing on the faith. They passed on the dignity of being apostles as well as the authority to teach. This passing on will continue until the end of the world.

(CCC 78) This living transmission is what we call Tradition. It is distinct from Sacred Scripture, but the two are closely linked. It is through the Tradition of the Church that our doctrine, life, and worship are transmitted through the ages.

(CCC 79) The Tradition of the Church holds authority in the world. Just as God the Father spoke the Word (the Son) in the Holy Spirit, so the living tradition of the Church is guided by the Holy Spirit to this day. As such, if the Church speaks in Her authority, it is the word of God Himself, guided and protected from error by the Holy Spirit, that is spoken today. This authority is given specifically so as to be able to lead believers to the fullness of truth.

Looking at these paragraphs together it is clear that Christianity is not a 'religion of the book.'

The written tradition (what we now call the Bible) did not even begin to be written down until decades after Christ founded the Church. Because of this, the Bible is not the sole authority of Christianity; Sacred Tradition is the other font from which our faith flows. So many Christians, including many Catholics, struggle with teachings of the Church because they are not always explicitly stated in scripture. This should not be a stumbling block for us since it is through Sacred Tradition that God continues to speak to us today.





