## ➤ From Father Barlett ◀

### Catechism of the Catholic Church 80-83; The Relationship Between Tradition and Sacred Scripture.

(CCC 80) Continuing our reflection from last week, although Sacred Scripture and Sacred Tradition are distinct from each other, they are bound closely together and communicate the same thing. They both have the same origin, “flowing from the same divine well-spring,” and come together to move souls toward the same goal. Each in their own way makes present to the Church the mystery of Christ. Because we have been graced to have these two modes of revelation, we would do well to reflect upon how each works uniquely in our lives.

(CCC 81) Sacred Scripture is the written words of God Himself put down in physical form for us to reference. It is by the power of the Holy Spirit that these words are written down without error. In Sacred Tradition, we find the entirety of the Word of God given to the Apostles passed down through the generations in their successors, the Bishops. In this mode of transmission, we see the Holy Spirit leading those successors of the Apostles in not only being able to hand on the words of Christ but also to expound upon and explain them to the faithful through their preaching.

(CCC 82) Because we have these two modes of transmitting the faith, the Church does not derive Her certainty of the faith through scripture alone. Both modes, Sacred Scripture and Sacred Tradition, must be accepted and honored as equal to each other.

This point is one we need to keep central in our dealings with other faiths and denominations. Ecumenical work, the good work of reaching out to other religions, always starts from commonalities we have. An example is starting with scripture when talking to other Christian denominations. Once that base connection has been made, it is important to remember the reason for Ecumenical work: conversion. Many will only stay in the areas we have in common with other faiths and so fail to hand on the richness of what God offers. We want to be charitable, but also at the same time bold, in professing the truth which comes from this Sacred Tradition. A Christian does not hide the fact that they recognize the authority of the Bible; we should not hide the fact that we have the authority of Sacred Tradition. (Continued Next Column)

(CCC 83) This Sacred Tradition is one which is traced all the way back to the Apostles themselves. It is in Sacred Tradition that the first generation of Christians had any revelation, for Sacred Scripture had not even begun being written. In fact, the very existence of the New Testament is a proof of the presence of Sacred Tradition. This gift goes all the way back to the very beginnings of the Church. Sacred Tradition (also known as ‘Big T’ Tradition) is distinct from local (little t) traditions developed over time. These can include various theological, disciplinary, liturgical, or devotional traditions. So long as they do not counter Tradition, these other traditions are acceptable in the life of the Church.


