

Pastor's Corner

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. This Feast brings the Christmas Season to its conclusion. This Feast is always a wonderful reminder of the gift of our own Baptism, the Blessed Day of our initiation into the life of the Lord and his Church! Original sin forgiven, our souls forever marked with Christ, the promise of salvation and everlasting life through Christ! Today is a good day to remember with gratitude, those (most likely our parents), who thought enough of their faith to hand it on to us. As the Archbishop always like to remind the young people, "Our Baptism is the greatest day of our life."



When we think of "Epiphany," we usually think of the story of the Wise Men coming to the manger and recognizing in the Baby Jesus, the promised Messiah, Savior and Lord! But along with that event, we also name two other events in the life of the Lord under the title Epiphany. These events are Jesus' Baptism in the Jordan River as well as the Wedding Feast of Cana. Remember "Epiphany" is about the manifestation and revelation of who Jesus is: "The Christ of God" - The Wise Men recognize Jesus as Lord. At his Baptism, the heavens were opened and the Father's voice was heard revealing Jesus as God's Beloved Son. The Wedding Feast of Cana is the setting for Christ's first miracle, changing water into wine. But the truth is, Epiphanies of Christ are not limited to these events, but are found throughout the Gospel.

With our celebration of the Lord's Baptism and the Gospel of the Wedding Feast of Cana next week, I thought these were good invitations to pray the Luminous Mysteries of the Rosary. Remember, Pope John Paul II added these five "new" mysteries to the rosary as we marked the Great Jubilee of 2000 Years of Christ and entered the third millennium. Most of us can name and pray the Joyful, Sorrowful, and Glorious Mysteries. We grew up with them! Can you name the Luminous or "mysteries of light?" Have you made the Luminous Mysteries part of your prayer? Here they are: 1. The Baptism of our Lord in the Jordan River 2. The Miracle at the Wedding Feast of Cana 3. The Proclamation of the Kingdom of God and The Call to Conversion 4. The Transfiguration of Our Lord 5. The Institution of the Holy Eucharist.

Our tradition of praying the various mysteries on specific days is as follows: Monday & Saturday: The Joyful Mysteries; Tuesday & Friday: The Sorrowful Mysteries; Wednesday & Sunday: The Glorious Mysteries; Thursday: The Luminous Mysteries. The Church teaches that in following this pattern, we continually recall the sacred mysteries which are the basis of Christian life: the incarnation of the Son of God as the beginning of our salvation; the life and works of Jesus as the revelation of the Kingdom of God; his obedience as the guiding principal of our life; his passion and death as the price of our redemption; his resurrection and ascension into heaven as the proof of his divinity and fulfillment of everything he taught; the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, who is with us, strengthening us and filling us with his gifts, and the raising up of the humble Virgin Mary, who was the first to be sanctified by Christ and who (from the cross), was given to us as our loving mother.

I pray that 2022 is a year of "Epiphany" for each of us where Christ is realized, manifested, and known more and more each day!

This weekend all parishes throughout the Archdiocese kick off the annual Archbishop's Call to Share Appeal. Each of us heard the Archbishop's message at Mass asking for our support in helping to fund the various ministries and services of our Archdiocesan Church. Each parish has been assigned a target goal. The target goal for Nativity is \$435,000. Each registered household will receive a mailing from Archbishop Naumann this week. Let's all do what we can to help meet the goal.

May the Lord bless and keep you throughout 2022! Fr. Mike





How To Report Abuse In Our Archdiocese.

The Archdiocese remains committed to investigating any allegation of abuse of a minor made against any member of the clergy or any Church employee or volunteer — no matter the age of the incident or the current age of the victim. If you suspect abuse, immediately report to civil authorities:


