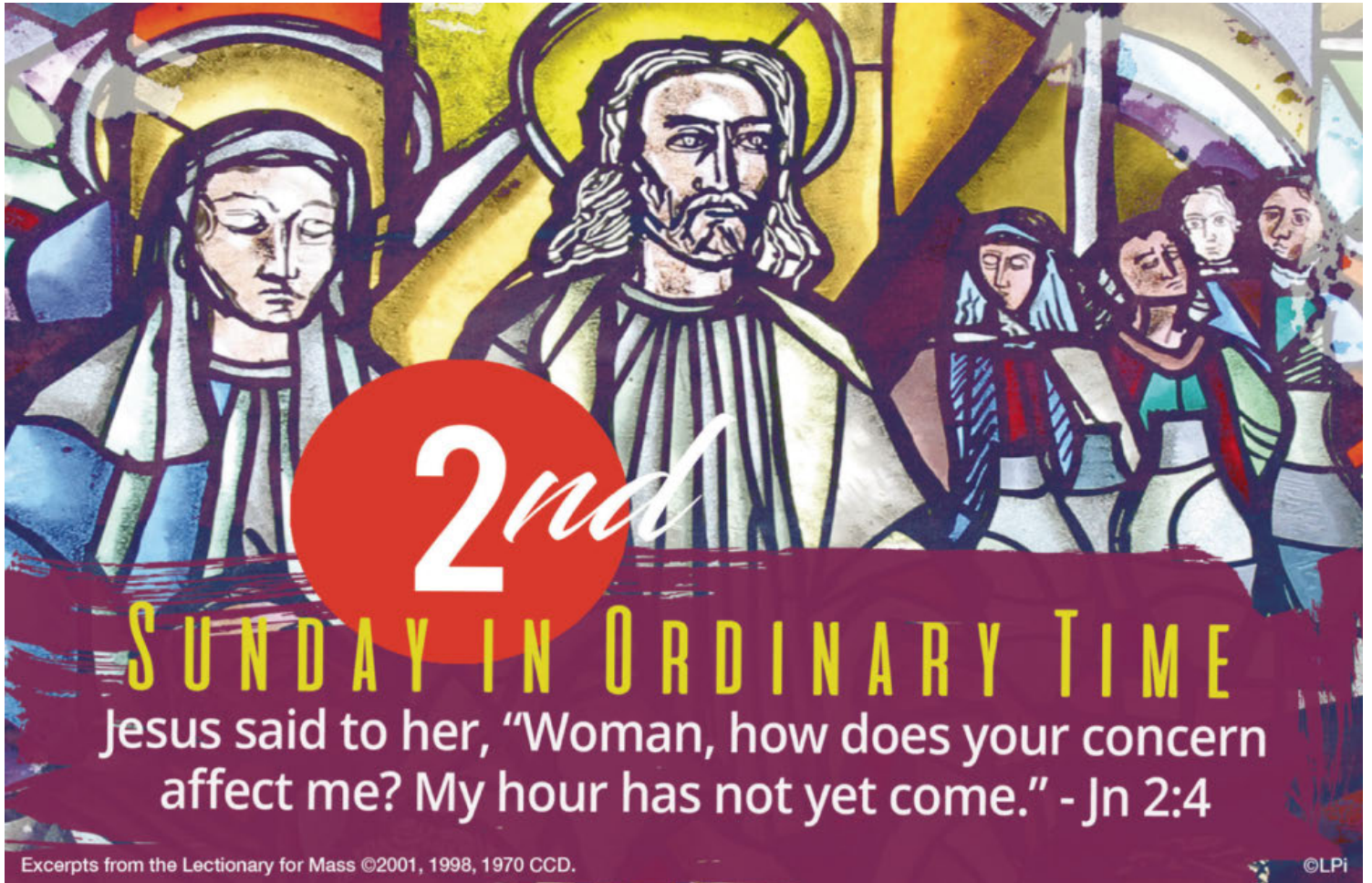

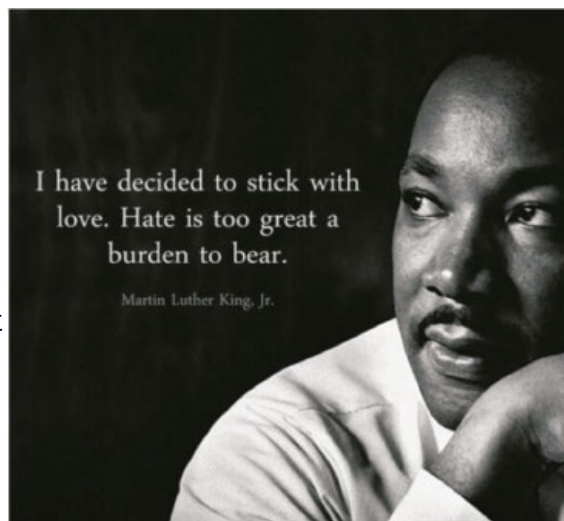
Pastor's Corner

This Sunday, our second reading comes from St. Paul's 1st Letter to the Corinthians. We will continue hearing passages from this letter until Lent begins. It's a wonderful letter about the Church; who we are as the Body of Christ, the unique gifts and talents of individual members given by the Spirit for the vitality and good of the Church, as well as instruction and conduct for Christian living. In teaching about the Church, Paul will use the image of the human body and compare it to the Body of Christ. In Paul's mind, it's easy to reason that if a part of the human body is missing or not working properly, then the body does not work or function as well as it could. Paul makes that application to the Body of Christ - the Church. Since each of us makes up part of the Body of Christ, if we are not participating, using our gifts, sharing of ourselves for the good of the Church, then we are not all that we can be! Bottom line? Each member is so important. You are so important in making the Body of Christ, the Church, all that we can be! Thanks for the ways that your presence, your prayer and worship, your gifts, talents, abilities, energy and financial resources are shared so generously for the good of Nativity Parish. Each member makes a difference, adding to the dynamic, vitality and spirit, making Nativity the wonderful parish we are!

Praying with the Church this week...

January 18 -25 marks the annual Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. For more than 100 years, Christians around the world have taken part in an octave of prayer for visible Christian unity. By annually observing the WPCU, Christians move toward the fulfillment of Jesus' prayer at the Last Supper "that they all may be one." It's also a week to be in solidarity with Christians who are persecuted for their faith. There is a great article in this month's *Word Among Us* on Christian Unity titled "That They May Be One – God's Heart for Christian Unity."

Monday, January 17 celebrates the birth of Martin Luther King, Jr., a national holiday in the USA. The Church reminds us that it is a good day to pray for an end to racial discrimination wherever it exists. A few memorable quotes by Dr. King: "The time is always right to do what is right." "Injustice anywhere is a threat to justice everywhere." "I have decided to stick with love. Hate is too great a burden to bear."



Wednesday, January 19 the US Catholic bishops are inviting the faithful to participate in 9 Days for Life, a novena for the protection of human life taking place January 19-27, 2022. Each day's intention is accompanied by a short reflection and suggested actions to help build a culture of life. Visit 9daysforlife.com to sign up for daily prayers sent by email or text message, or to download the free mobile app.

Friday, January 21 many of our area high school students and other representatives of the Archdiocese will be at the March for Life in Washington this week. Six students from Nativity are headed to Washington with their high school and two students and their mother are going with Meghan, our youth minister. Keep them in your prayers as well.

Saturday, January 22 marks the 49th anniversary of the Roe vs. Wade decision which legalized abortion in our country. It's sad to realize that in the past 49 years, more than 63 million abortions have happened. This anniversary reminds us again of our call to proclaim the Gospel of Life; human life is sacred from conception until natural death. For a greater respect for human life in our world, for an end to all atrocities committed against human life, and for the grace to see the image and likeness of God in every human person, we pray!

May the Peace of Christ be in our hearts and in our homes.

Wine Club Winter Event

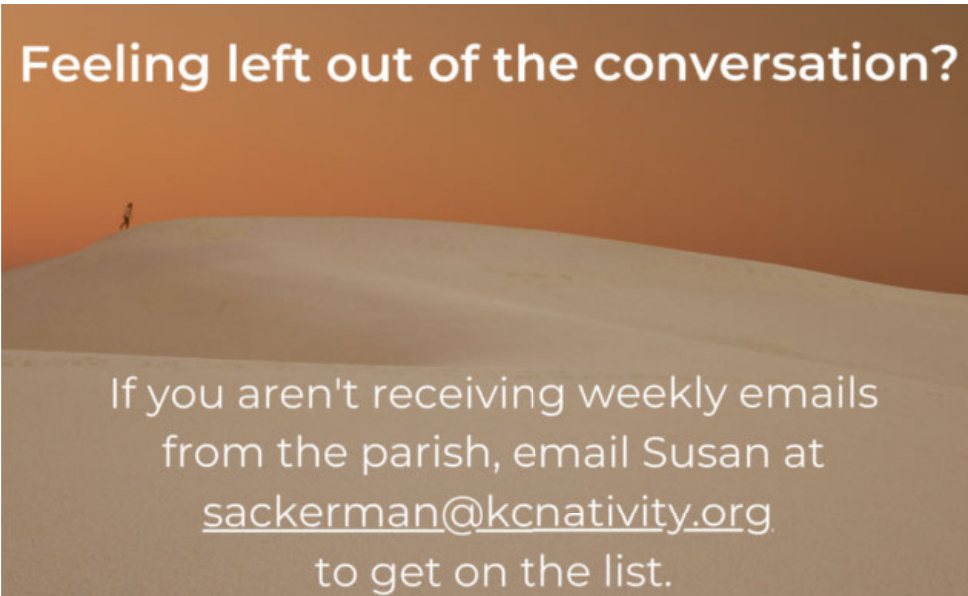

How To Report Abuse In Our Archdiocese.

The Archdiocese remains committed to investigating any allegation of abuse of a minor made against any member of the clergy or any Church employee or volunteer — no matter the age of the incident or the current age of the victim. If you suspect abuse, immediately report to civil authorities:

1. Call the Kansas Protection Report Center at (800)922-5330 or report online at Reporting Abuse, Neglect and Exploitation of Adult and Child - Prevention and Protection Services (ks.gov)

2. Contact law enforcement if anyone is in immediate danger or injured. If the suspected abuse involves a cleric, employee, or volunteer of the Archdiocese, call the Archdiocesan Report Line at (913) 647-3051 or visit archkck.org/reportabuse. We care about survivors of abuse. Victim Care Advocate: (913) 298-9244.
