



January 22nd is the **Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children** and also the 48th anniversary of Roe vs. Wade. It is a tragedy of the greatest magnitude that millions of children have lost their lives, and millions of women and families have been wounded by abortion. The gift of life is holy and amazing! We must protect life. Could we imagine for adults that we would place rights of privacy and choice above the right to life? That one could kill another adult as long as a greater right of choice and privacy was claimed? It is ridiculous. Yet, that is exactly what has been done to unborn children in the legalization of abortion. The difference between an adult human and an unborn human is really just a matter of time. Why is it legal at one time to take a life and not another? We have to continue to stand up for and pray for the legal protection of unborn children. At the same time we must do all we can to help make the choice for life easier for all people, so that there is support for mothers and fathers in difficult situations, resources, and better options like adoption. We must love and protect all human life from conception until natural death. It is most assuredly a both/and effort—to both change laws and hearts, to both promote the truth and act with love and mercy.



As individuals, we are called to observe January 22nd through the penitential practices of prayer, fasting and/or almsgiving. You're also invited to join thousands of Catholics nationwide in prayer for the respect of human life during a special novena called 9 Days for Life. Visit 9daysforlife.com to sign up to receive daily intentions from January 21st through the 29th.

I'd also like to highlight two important post-abortive ministries – Project Rachel and Project Joseph. These ministries help those who have been involved in an abortion to find mercy, forgiveness, and healing in God. Notes on the Liturgy

Reflection for the Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

This Sunday's readings revolve around hearing and answering God's call in our life.

Our music selections reflect this, especially in our song during the presentation of gifts and preparation of the altar. "Here I Am, Lord" is a good text for reflection: "Here I am, Lord. Is it I, Lord? I have heard you calling in the night. I will go, Lord, if you lead me." (D. Schutte)

The text to "Servant Song" is another good reflection to use throughout our busy week in our prayers: "What do you want of me, Lord? Where do you want me to serve you? Where can I sing your praises?" (D. McCargill, OSM)

Are we hearing God's call in our lives like Samuel in the first reading? Are we letting others in our life point us toward Jesus, like John the Baptist did with Andrew and Simon Peter in the Gospel? Do we know that it is God calling, or are we confusing it with the other distractions in our world? Are we using our prayer time throughout the week to reflect on what it is that God is calling us to? All of the scripture and musical texts, of course, lead us to the final hymn and the ultimate reason for answering God's call: "Go make of all disciples...inspire our ways of learning through earnest, fervent prayer, and let our daily living reveal you everywhere." Newly Engaged Couples

Matrimony celebrates and witnesses the covenant of love between two people and symbolizes in that union Christ's covenant of love for the Church. **Six months** preparation is required before the marriage of a Catholic. Arrangements must be made to complete the necessary paperwork/requirements.

For information and guidelines on the Marriage Prep process at Prince of Peace, please visit our website, popolathe.org/marriage. According to Canon Law, anyone seeking the Sacrament of Matrimony at Prince of Peace must be living in our parish boundaries. They should be registered and active in the parish prior to contacting the Parish Office to begin marriage preparations.

The exact date and time for a wedding cannot be scheduled until the engaged couple has had their 'Initial Consultation' with one of the parish Priests. **IMPORTANT NOTE: Do not schedule a reception venue prior to this Initial Consultation.**

In support of Marriage, we will be recognizing parishioners who are celebrating 25, 50 or 75 years of Marriage. Please contact the Parish Office with your anniversary date so we can update our Sacramental information, and with your formal request to have a blessing on your 25th, 50th or 75th Anniversary. 




