If you wish to have a Mass said for a person living or deceased, please contact the Parish Office at 651-925-8800. The schedule of Masses for 2022 has been available for a few months so there are several dates that are already taken but we still have many dates available. If you wish specific dates, it gets a bit more difficult but we will do our best to accommodate. Here are a few guidelines to follow:

1. There is a limit of 12 Masses per requester per year.
2. There is a limit of one Mass per month for a person.
3. There is a limit of 6 Masses for weekends (Saturday Vigils and Sundays) for a requester.
4. Masses are reserved on a first-come basis and are put in the book when the stipend is received.

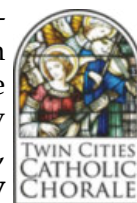


## CHORALE AND ORCHESTRA NOTES
