Our activities include high ropes, paintball, blobbing, archery tag, giant swing, dual zip lines, a 5-story climbing wall, vertical play-pen, extreme capture the flag, swimming and low ropes.

Every camper gets the opportunity to participate in every activity. We encourage campers to conquer fears and step out of their comfort zone but will not force campers to participate in any activity.

Payment information and a \$150 initial deposit are required when you reserve your spot, and you may select a payment plan that divides the remaining cost across installments.

CYSC began as a traveling summer camp in 2001, but with the move to Damascus Catholic Mission Campus, *things have changed*. CYSC served on only one site in Ohio until 2021, but with the invitation to serve more young people in Minnesota, *things have changed*. And CYSC has known four staffs since 2016, but with the need to serve more campers than ever before, *things have changed*.

In 2021, a team of 5 Damascus missionaries began living in Minnesota and serving in the Archdiocese of St. Paul and Minneapolis. During the summers, a larger team of missionaries will serve as counselors, activity facilitators, kitchen staff, and everything else that goes into an unforgettable week of camp.

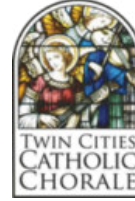

Joseph Haydn, *Kleineorgelsolomesse*

The *Kleine Orgelsolomesse* was composed by Joseph Haydn (1732–1809) between 1775 and 1778. It is officially titled *Missa Brevis Sancti Joanni de Deo*, honoring Saint John of God (1495–1550), the Spanish founder and patron saint of the Brothers Hospitaller, who had one of their hospitals in Eisenstadt.

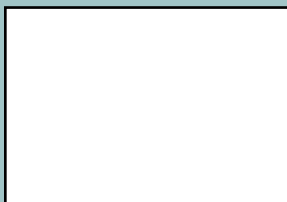
